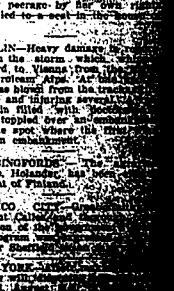
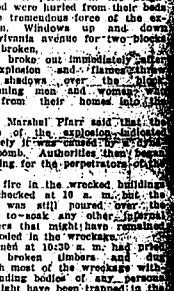
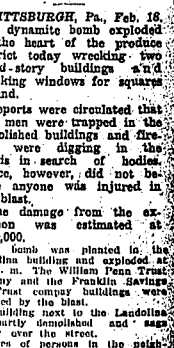
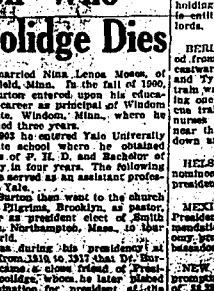
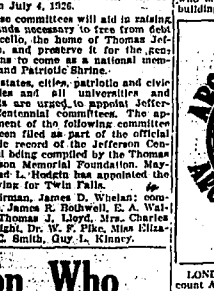
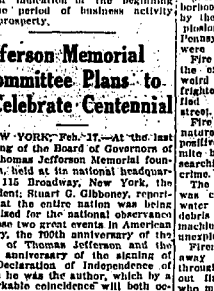
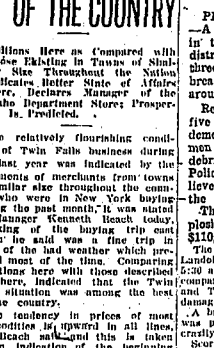
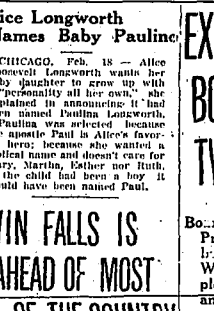
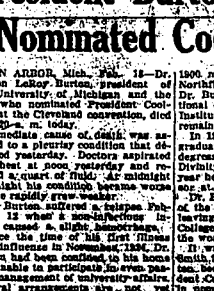
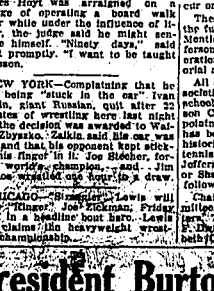
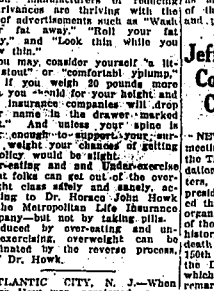
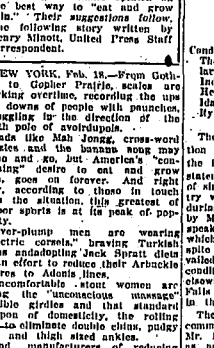
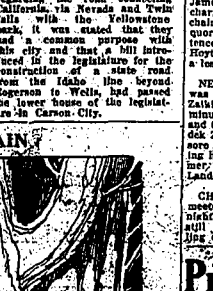
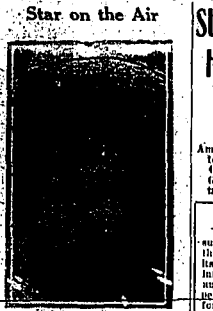
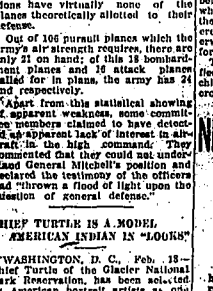
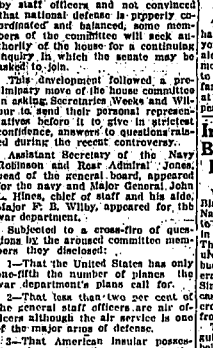
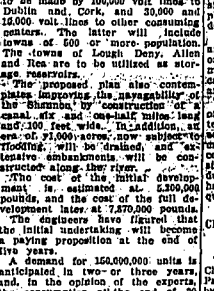
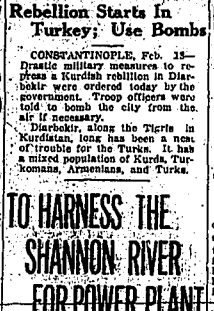
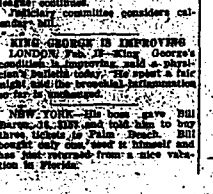
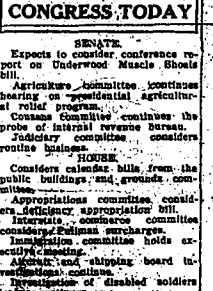
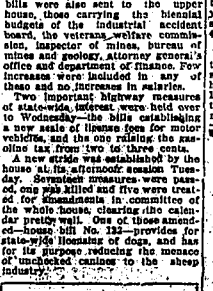
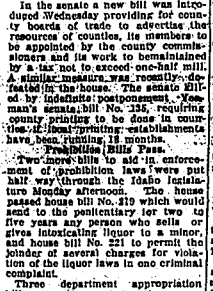
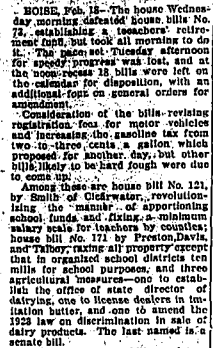
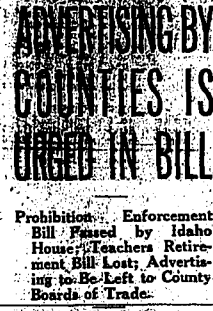
Boob Planted in Heart of Produce District of Pittsburgh Explodes and Wrecks Buildings; People Hurled From Beds and Windows Broken.

PITTSBURGH, Pa., Feb. 18.—A dynamite bomb exploded in the heart of the produce district today wrecking two three-story buildings and blowing windows for squares around.

Reports were circulated that five men were trapped in the demolished buildings and fire men were digging in the debris in search of bodies. Police, however, did not believe anyone was injured in the blast.

The damage from the explosion was estimated at \$11,000.

The bomb was planted in the Landolin building and exploded at 6:30 p. m. The William Penn Company and the Franklin Savings and Trust company buildings were damaged by the blast.
