The opening of the railroad to California is bound to open an important market to the dairy farmers and creameries of the Twin Falls tract in San Francisco and other points in the Golden state. A tremendous increase in the demand for butter is accompanied by a decided slump in the number of cows in California, and the situation in Montana is such that no great supply can be expected from that state for several years.

The following from the Seattle Post-Intelligencer of September 19 is indicative of a condition that must be of interest to futter producers of the Twin Falls tract and all southern Idaho:

Reports from Montana indicate that shipments of butter may be reduced sharply at any time. Local, receivers have been making exhaustive inquiries among the creamery men of that state for fresh supplies but to little purpose. At Washington and Oregon points many of the smaller country creameries are buying butter in Seattle. Dairying in the Northwest is now on a highly remunative hasis; according to leading jobbers, but production is far behind the demand. There is apparently no danger of an oversupply for two or three years, as mileh cows in process of coming on the market will not mature-for a couple of more seasons, and top graide butter, it is believed, will be short until production comes up to the demand. Local creamery men have been scouring the country, side to get enough butter to take care of the local and shipping demand. The heavy increase of population in California has kept ahead of milk and butter production in short samples and Loca Angeles is drawing daily from the short supply in this stated and Oregon. A tense situation is to be expected until more producing cows come into the local market.
