FARRELL PICKS THE SENATORS TO WIN PENNANT

Pitching Is Big Factor and Writer Believes Bucky Harris of the Washington Team Has Ability to Switch Twirlers to Gain Decided Leads.

PITTSBURGH, Oct. 6.—After considering the pitching, fielding and hitting strength of the principals in the world's series and the mental makeup of the two teams, it is my belief that the Washington Senators will win the series from the Pittsburgh Pirates.

It is only a guess and it is no better than the opinion of a man who thinks he is willing to wager that the flashy Pittsburgh club will defeat the Washington veterans.

The Pirates are considered stronger than the Senators because of more quantity of good pitching, heavier hitting front eight men in the lineup who are 200 feet better and more efficient. An analysis of the figures will show that these advantages are not so great.

Comparing the last strike the Pirates had with the National League in term length with an average of .306 and the Senators were leading the American League in the number of games won had stolen 142 bases and the veteran Senators had stolen 122. There is not any great difference in these figures.

When it comes to pitching it does not seem that the Pirates have more good pitchers than the Senators but the Pirates staff isn't as flexible as the Washington team manager in baseball can handle and mix up his pitchers as well as young Bucky Harris did in the series.

Harris, however, has the Giants last year, knew almost exactly how many innings his pitchers were good for and made his plans accordingly. He did in Miami, too, and the result was that the greatest relief pitcher in baseball had to go to a valuable pitcher in the series.

The most important factor in a series like this is so much money at stake to the individual players is experience. Both players can go into the series stronger than the Washington team has been in the past. The Washington team will have a tremendous advantage over the National League champions.

THE INTERPARLIAMENTARY UNION

The Interparliamentary Union meeting in Washington is likely to prove a factor for good and for the solving of international problems. It has endorsed the movements of the League of Nations and of the Pan American Union for a general conference on disarmament and for the codification of international law, and it has approved of the world court for the hearing of disputes between nations. Pan Americanism as an organized movement was discussed immediately after the Latin American nations obtained their freedom from Spain. It was given the greatest impetus by James G. Blaine, who was instrumental in getting through a resolution in favor of arbitration of all questions between the countries of the western world, although this was not at the time ratified by the governments represented. Blaine realized that union of commercial interests would be a powerful factor in cementing the friendship of the several nations, hence he stressed.

When leaders of the world's parliaments get together as they have done within the past couple of weeks and consider the things that they have in common, much good should result, and will result, if the people, whom they represent will heed the lesson which the legislators bring home to them. The meeting did not specifically advocate joining the League of Nations by the United States or by the few countries now outside that society, but probably went as far in the direction of international peace as could be expected.

WHAT is the future of the NEA? President Coolidge is due for trouble at the next session of Congress, not saving enough money, and spending too much.




