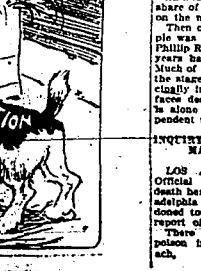

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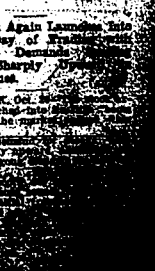

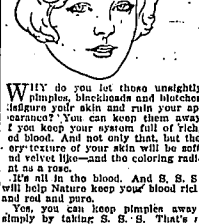

AIRMAN SEEKS TWIN FALLS FLYING FIELD

Canadian Flier Who Will Give Exhibitions, Urges City to Develop Permanent Airport That It May Prosper By New Air Mail, Express and Passenger

With the arrival here of Captain William Gibson of Toronto, Canada, here another of the World War pilots is considered by local interests to be the first step toward attempting the development of permanent flying fields for Twin Falls will have a competitor.

Captain Gibson, a former officer of the Royal Air Force and decorated for bravery, is appearing in Twin Falls for an attempt to acquire the land for a flying field. He is a Canadian citizen and is interested in aeronautics and hopes to win his pilot in obtaining a permanent field here.

At present, he declares, the middle, and greatly so, the Twin Falls field is in the hands of the city and is being used for a landing field. If landing fields are lacking, the state naturally will issue when it comes to the establishment of air mail and air express and passenger routes. While here he will make a number of exhibition flights, taking thousands of passengers, city officials and industry primarily influential in the possible establishment of a field.

A conference was held last night at which Charles Dwyer, secretary of the chamber of commerce, took a leading part. In the discussion of the prospective field, a temporary field was selected near the city. It is doubtful at this time whether a field could be purchased, but it might be arranged that one be leased or rented. Mr. Dwyer said. Another firm in Twin Falls is Congressman Addison T. Smith, who said that there would be more air mail routes established through this section in the near future without a doubt and that he believes Twin Falls to have a field.

Clean Milk Production Brings Back the Money

That season of the year is here when milk is so often returned to the shipper because it is unfit for consumption has arrived in a new condition. Flavor and others in milk result from four causes and it would be well for the milk producer to note these causes and guard against shipping milk which cannot be used, thereby saving a big loss to his business this season.

These causes are as follows:

1. Internal or physical condition of the cow.
2. Flavors and odors absorbed within the body of the cow from lightly flavored feeds such as turnips, cabbage, etc.
3. Odors absorbed into the milk during production.
4. Bacterial development within milk while standing.

Control of these four factors this summer will mean dollars and cents in the milk producer's pocket. These factors are also very important for the cream producer, to consider, as high quality butter cannot be made from low-quality cream, and if the butter-maker cannot make superior butter demanding a higher price, he cannot possibly give the producer any more for his product.—H. R. Lawless, field man, Colorado State Dairy Commission.

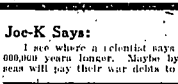

FAMOUS FORTS IN U.S. HISTORY

By ELMO SCOTT WATSON

Christopher Greene Here Won Fame

The post with which you are acquainted is of utmost importance to America. The whole defense of the Delaware depends upon it, and consequently all the enemy's hopes of keeping Philadelphia and finally succeeding in the present campaign. So wrote George Washington to Col. Christopher Greene, a brave officer who had fought under Arnold and Montgomery at Quebec. It was now in this tenth year of 1777 given command of Fort Mifflin at Red Bank on the river. Fort Mifflin and Fort Mifflin named Gen. Hugh Mercer were two threats against Philadelphia. Fort Mifflin was captured and Greene and Greene was given 400 Rhode Island Continentals to hold the post.

Greene immediately began preparing the fort into condition, a work in which he was greatly aided by Capt. Mifflin Dupont, a young French engineer who had been captured at the Battle of Brandywine. Before the repairs were completed, however, a force of 1,200 British grenadiers led by Gen. Mifflin Dupont, appeared and demanded its surrender. Greene scornfully replied that he would defend it to the last and refused to be frightened when Dupont declared that no quarter would be given if he was forced to take Fort Mifflin by storm.

As the divisions crossed by a heavy artillery fire, advanced in two columns across the outskirts of the fort. After pouring a galling fire on the British, the Rhode Islanders retired to the main works where they concealed themselves to give the British the idea that the post was poorly garrisoned. When the enemy poured showers of broadside shells and was made in the fourth round, they gave a great cheer as though the victory was already won.

But that moment, concealed battery was unmasked and accompanied by a heavy artillery fire it poured out a hail of shot upon the British. The attackers reeled back. On the south side of the fort Capt. Dupont, leading the first in person, went down bravely wounded. His second in command was also stricken, and although the men in command tried hard to hold the post, the stubborn resistance of the Rhode Islanders and their destructive fire had broken the spirit of the British who retreated precipitately.

In this crisis the enemy had more than 200 guns. The American loss was only eight killed and twenty nine wounded! This brilliant defense brought a brilliant hope to the country in the line of the British in the Revolution, and Congress recognized the achievement of Colonel Greene by naming Mifflin's day of the year. 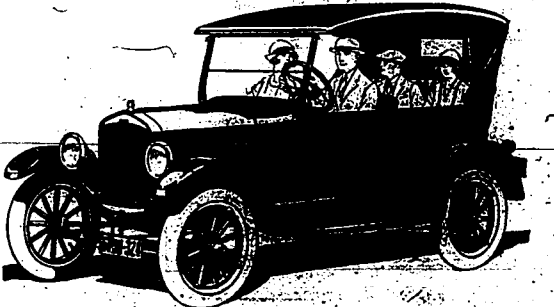
