

We hope they will prove efficient and economical because there has been a vast waste under the direction of this board in the past and the people of Twin Falls county have a dead horse which they must pay for with a fictitious valuation of one and a quarter million dollars. The strange thing about this rock crusher deal is that we have not yet started to pay for this tremendous blunder. We hope that the new board will buy gravel at home rather than send to Burley or somewhere else for same.

The women of Twin Falls who opposed the suggestion of placing garbage cans along the streets of this city before the city council last evening are to be congratulated for their courage and for the stamina to stand by their opinions. There are some who favored this suggestion but the majority were against such an idea. Just as one of the commissioners stated if the city feels that there is a great need of receptacles of this kind the city itself can install these at much less than twelve hundred dollars and can maintain them at much less than one hundred and fifty dollars per month? This is the proposed cost by this outside corporation which was trying to get permission to install the devices for waste paper and refuse. The less of these receptacles for garbage that we place on our streets the cleaner looking will be our city because these always smell and attract files in summer.

GOODING'S RATE BILL

In view of the fact that there will be a great deal of discussion, some misunderstanding and perhaps, some misrepresentation of the modified Gooding long and short haul bill during the next year it is well to keep in mind what that measure, as finally announced in the dispatches yesterday provides. The dispatches say, "Its purport and effect are the same as the old bill and affect the intermountain country identically. * * * * The new bill will merely add a new paragraph to section 4 of the interstate commerce act and does not change the existing long and short haul clause save as it is limited by the new section. The only real modification of the present law is that the new section removes the discretion of the interstate commerce commission to go back to the old system which prevailed prior to the time when McAdoo assumed charge of the roads. Up to that time the commission exercised its legal right to make a lower rate to the coast than to the inland country, where it was deemed necessary to meet water competition. In other words it cost more to ship some articles, say from Chicago to Pocatello than from Chicago to Portland. Under the present rule, put in force by McAdoo, which Senator Gooding would crystallize into law, the road may charge as much for a shipment from Chicago to Portland but not more except as set forth in the measure. The proposed law reads:

"No common carrier shall be authorized to charge less for a longer than for a shorter distance for the transportation of passengers or of a like kind of property over the same line or route in the same direction, the shorter being included within the longer distance, on account of water competition either actual or potential or direct or indirect, provided that such authorizations, on account of water competition, as may be lawfully in effect on December 7, 1925, shall not be required to be changed except upon the further order of the commission; and provided further that provision of this paragraph shall not apply to states on import or export traffic,


