Miss Hep-worth declares that vegetables are rich in calcium, phos-phorus and iron, all vitally important to growing children. She also declares that some vegetables should occasional-Iy be eaten raw in order to make sure of obtaining much desired vitamines, as well as a proper supply of lime.


