TWIN FALLS COUNTY SHOULD GO SLOW BEFORE SELLING THE HOSPITAL

The county commissioners ought to be sure of what they are doing before they sell the county hospital. Perhaps this is too much to ask of the present board, but they should do their best. One argument against the retention of the hospital is unfair, or at least exaggerated. It is assumed that there would be no larger indigent charge under a private hospital system than at present. This overlooks the fact that many same day as high as three thousand those who run accounts at the hospital which are not collectable, people who would necessarily receive services as indigents in private hospitals and have their accounts paid out of the county fund as such, were the county hospital sold to private persons. That something like this is the case might be inferred from the elaborate report on the hospital filed January 1, 1924, before the present board made its reorganization, which it is said will necessitate a higher hospital levy next year.

This report showed that in June, 1923, the sum of \$118,957.73 in bills was turned over to a collection agency. Of these the agency turned back as uncollectible \$6,460.17; it collected \$932.92 and this left in the hands of the agency on the date named, January 1, 1924, the sum of \$6,458.74. The exact percentage of this last since collected cannot be ascertained at present.

The report continues: "The chief reasons for bad and slow accounts are as follows:

"(1) - That the hospital is the recipient of all transient sick who are without means to pay for their care outside the hospital, and without the necessary facilities to care for themselves outside. This class while not exactly indigents, have no money and leave the county within a few months and are almost impossible to trace. They give their note willingly but have nothing for security.

"(2) - A small percentage of very large bills covering a long period of hospitalization incurred by worthy, but poor patients, who shrink from county help, and ask that the account be left open in the hopes that they will be able to pay at some future time.

"(3) - A surprising percentage of people who believe it is all right to let the county wait, who make a practice of paying their other just debts. These will no doubt be paid in time but aid materially in making collections 'poor.' Then there is a small percentage whose attitude is that since this is a county hospital they are entitled to care, and paying for same is optional with themselves. We are continually being confronted with the statement, 'I pay taxes to the hospital and should be entitled to long time credit.'

It is safe to say that all in the first class and a majority in the second class who have to be treated as indigents at the hospital, should become a private institution and the accounts would be charged up and allowed. Such charges would be added to the present cost of caring for indigents. Collections by a private institution would probably be better in the third class in a private than in a public institution.

The county hospital was built after long and careful consideration of the effect of the sale should be given before it is disposed of to private individuals or institutions.


