The commission forced a poor card for the Christmas fund on Rickard and when the bills were paid, the promoter had to pay out of his own pocket the balance of the bill, or \$11,000, which is a sizeable contribution for any charity.

Then he had a prospective money maker blown out from under him when the commission refused to allow him to book a fight with the world's champion, Billy Walker, for the world's lightweight championship.

After considerable money had been spent in arranging and advertising the match,

The attempt of the commission to force a light-heavyweight championship fight between Harry Heintz and Mike Neftics on Rickard further pained the promoter.


