## SERVANTS OR SPOILERS

Commencement Day is Democracy's Day of Destiny! On this day our greatest factory—the public school—is delivering its finished product. Every graduate represents an enormous investment of time and sacrifice on the part of the parents, the public, the professors and the pupils. Now begins the dividend period.

The future of democracy depends upon whether the schools have trained us for servants or spoilsmen.

It is an important thing for American youth to master the intricacies of mathematics and science, but it is vastly more important that they shall be the masters of themselves—that they shall have in subjection the fires and passions of their own bodies, the wild impulses of their imaginations and the predatory instincts of the jungle from which they have so recently escaped.

It is a good thing for them to know literature, but will they know themselves? Do they know of the existence of those great mental powers by which they may "know all mysteries"? Are they aware of the hideous tyrannies that lurk in their own aptitudes once that those aptitudes have become masters and are no longer servants?

Can the American youth summon the forces of his mind and soul and concentrating them on some new problem or emergency, be trusted to work out a salvation, not only for himself, but for us all?

It is not enough that we be assured that he is wise. Democracy is asking "Is he safe?" He is trained. To what purpose will he put this training? Will he use his sharpened wits and trained faculties to bring us under him or will he lift us up as he lifts himself?

We are soon to turn over to him the richest government, the most precious ideals and the most dearly bought liberties in the possession of any people under the sun. Will he use them to safeguard and serve us, or will he, sealing them, turn upon us and rend us?

In the answers to these questions lies the verdict that the future will pass upon the American school.

Dean George Dowrie of the School of Business of the University of Minnesota, says: "The greatest tragedies which I have to deal are the disillusioned students who have gone out from us with high ideals of service only to discover that the altruistic principles upon which they have been trained are not the ones by which the world does business."

The new graduate comes as a problem and a challenge. Will he fail us? Will we fail him? If he comes to serve us will we accept him or crucify him?

The whole country is glad of the success of the Seattle woman, and her success goes to prove that men are willing, more than willing, to give women her chance and to help her advance in politics as they have in business, the arts, sciences and professions. The whole country is glad of the success of the woman, for it proves that communities, after all, are decent and want good government, and Seattle, from all accounts, was little short of a cess-pool of civic unrighteousness under the rule of the administration just defeated.



# CANAL AUDIT SUPPLEMENT IS ON FILE

Comments, Criticisms and Recommendations Are Made in Full Report of Auditor Which Was Received by Board Tuesday; Strong Collecting Urged; Methods of Taking Inventories Are Censured and Suggestions Made.

Having heard the presentation of the new Herz project for waterizing the Salmon tract, the Twin Falls canal board yesterday afternoon took up the completed audit matter, adopting a resolution to accept it.

The audited amounts, at the request of the board, filled a partial report some weeks ago, a summary of which was published in the Times of April 26. This did not contain the figures concerning the audit, the facts from the sloping of the auditor, and showing no conclusion that would throw new light on the results of some of the existing conditions.

The full report, yesterday contained such interpretation.

A complete audit plan is vigorously in the annual audit submitted yesterday to the canal board by the Twin Falls Canal company by Edwin A. Wilson Auditing company.

The difficulties in carrying out audit system under the conditions presented with the offsetting technical actions and other elements of confusion where lack of control is a factor in consideration.

**Brief Expenses.**

It is recommended that the expense budget be divided into three major sections: that improprieties in each case should be carefully estimated and not guessed at; and it is added that no account representing expenses or less than five dollars should be taken care of unless through survey of expense that it is necessary to make are recommended, before they are placed in the budget.

Owing to the magnitude of the system, such quantities of material as lumber, wire, etc., are constantly and much free cash held, amount should be excluded from the budget. It is stated so that both material and cash will be available as needed should collection not prove as expected.

As far as possible, the audit should be limited to the cost of materials, labor and overhead.
