THREE PASTORS IN SPOTLIGHT OF PUBLICITY TWO CENTERS OF GRAND JURY INVESTIGATION

SANTA ANA, Calif., July 21. Plans for the return of the Rev. Phillip J. Patterson, alleged pastor of the St. Paul, for the alleged murder of Jos. J. Patterson, Los Angeles stock broker, were under way today.

Patterson's wife was shipped to Miami, Arizona, today for burial, after a final examination. The remains were found in Santa Ana canyon last March and were only recently identified by the dead man's brother, H. E. Patterson.

Authorities, after examining and inspecting the body, expressed the belief that Patterson had been found and gagged, and his body saturated with gasoline and fired by a torch, before he was killed.

Although the evidence indicated Patterson was tortured to death by an unknown person, investigators believe that robbery was the real motive. A large sum of cash which the stockbroker carried, was gone, and all securities which he owned had been transferred to some other person. His bank account was drawn against by means of forged checks. It was discovered.
