# THE IDAHO LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

The nineteenth session of the Idaho legislature closed its work vesterday and we notice that practically all of the subsidized newspapers of the state have blazed the fact to the public that it was a harmonious session and we don't know of anyone who can dispute this statement because when the bosses rule harmony usually prevails. But cause when the bosses rule harmony usually prevails. But in our opinion there has never been a session so well oiled with political hogwash incident to such legislative assemblies. The Buldridge machine program went through without a hitch as far as we can learn and when some one even dared to suggest a change they were cut off sharply for venturing such audacity. The equitable distribution of the Idaho gas tax was one of the most important issues before the legislature and Twin Falls county made a fight with the aid and support of her representatives and senator for a proper distribution of this lax and against the raise in the gas tax. The Twin Falls delegation unanimously supported the hill for returning to the counties the proper share of the gas tax and also fought the raise of one edit for callon on gas which tends to give too large a slush fund for the state administration to use in Boise. As far as progressive legislation is concerned, the ninetentiresesion was almost a failure and yet the Associated Press, which co-ordinates with the republican machine in Idaho and other states, sends out stories to the effect that this was a harmonious session and we would like fett that the remove a remove and escale and the remove and

From start to finish the recent session of the legislature went out after more money and from the opening day to the finish the cry was "Boys, get the money." Governor Baldridge and his coloris went out and searched the records to find where they could place a raise of taxeon-the people who are already groaning under the terrific load of taxation in this state. The general levy in Idaho was raised by this bunch of high binders from 35 cents per one hundred dollars to 48 cents besides the extra cent which we must all pay on our gas consumed, in this state. To our way of thinking there may have been harmony but if it was harmony it was high handed harmony to gouge the people of this state. We have often been told that gooks must hang together or they may hang separately and verily we feel that this is true of the recent session of the Idaho legislature presided over and controlled by astate bosses.

During the 60 days an pnofficial count shows the hegislature has passed 394 bills, of which 224 originated in the house and 70 in the senate. Through defeat on the floor, indefinite postponement, tabling or smothering in committee 152 house bills and 66 senate bills were killed. Measures introduced totaled 476 in the house and 136 in the senate.

"Of the 324 house bills passed, 122 were validating acts to carry out the legislative program to legalize organization of the Idaho highway districts and their issuance of \$10.800.000 worth of bonds. By these enactments the state's integrity end credit has been maintained in that recent federal decisions declared liths bighway district organizations unconstitutional, which resulted in invalidation of outstanding bonds.

"With the exception of one motor vehicle act and the habitual criminal act, all of the recommendations contained in the legislative message of Governor H. C. Bald-

ridge have been met.

"Outstanding work of the session includes the formation of a highway program for maintenance and construction of incompleted arterial highways through enactment of the 4-cent gaseline tax. Estimated revenue during the biennium from the 4-cent tax has been placed a \$3,655,000 which with other highway revenue will provide approximately \$2,000 000 of state funds for highway maintenance and construction."






