

ANOTHER AERIAL CONQUEST

Clarence Chamberlin. intrepid American birdman, and the owner of his sirplane, Charles & Levine, have made another conquest of the air for the United States and set a new record for long distance non-stoj Tiying.

Starting early Saturday from New York, these two men remained aloft 44 hours and 35 minutes, traveling approximately 4,000 miles, and landed at a small town in Germany about 100 miles from Berlin. The landing was forced on account of the airplane's gasoline supply being exhausted. They refueled to go on to Berlin but 4 shattered propeller blade forced another landing at a town abhout 80 miles from the German capital city.

While the "olge" was taken off of the great feat performed by Chamberlin by the history-anaking flight of Capt. Charles A. Lindhergh in his recent non-stop trip from New York to Paris, the fact remains that Chamberlin outdistanced-Lindhergh by approximately 400 miles although his time wins not as fast.

While Lindhergh made the trip by himself, two were in the iterally while completed the trip into Germany systeriday. Chamberlin however, did all of the piloting, levine being unrely a passenger, and a frighthed-do and at hat. Repeats indicated that the owner of the plane was haggard and tired at the end of the frip while Chamberlin was in normal condition.
