NEW LEADERS, OLD ISSUES

The two most important newspapermen in the country are the New York Herald-Tribune and the Chicago Tribune.

The Herald-Tribune prints this from its Washington bureau: "Hoover and Davis, in the order named, are the most distinguished names as Coolidge's successors among political leaders here. Doubtless, however, the president will have had time to consider the racial prejudices of either's father. They are in the middle of the world's work now, and in the course of their lives have had to meet many of the world's leaders."

And this from its correspondent at Rapid City:

"The White House interpretation is that President Coolidge is almost surely not a candidate in the next campaign, and that he will be nominated if he wants to. To do otherwise, the president's intimates say, would involve sacrifice of respect. He does not regard to public favor."

The Herald-Tribune is one of the papers that, on the morning following the president's statement, insisted he would, nevertheless, be the next presidential candidate.

From the Washington bureau of the Chicago Tribune comes this dispatch:

"Evidences multiplied today that Secretary of Commerce Herbert Hoover will receive strong support from important administration groups for the republican presidential nomination. On high administration official expressed the belief that the New York state delegation, which was notorious for its opposition to Coolidge, would not nominate him, and that many other eastern states, would also line up for him."

"That the race will be between Hoover and Coolidge is the growing conviction of republicans close to the administration. It is the impression of President Coolidge, however, that he will not become a candidate as long as Mr. Landon, his close friend, is still alive. Mr. Hoover, however, will be certain to mount prominently if Mr. Landon, for any reason, is eliminated."

"That Mr. Coolidge is sincere in desiring to retire to private life at the end of his present term is more and more the belief of his friends in Washington."

This entire page might easily be filled with similar reports appearing in other newspapers; all in the refferer that Mr. Coolidge definitely out of it, and that the forces that have been supporting him are expected to align themselves behind Herbert Hoover to the "succession."

It is true enough, all speculative and conjectural, but it comes from most able and experienced speculators and conjecturists.

Here is another most interesting item of news, coming from one who is perhaps the cleverest man in the world, and its most specious theorist, the industrialist Henry Ford, says:

"I think that Herbert Hoover is a good man for the presidential campaign. This is a business generation and he is a business man. His experience as engineer, business administrator and cabinet member has been varied and successful and he has really been training for the presidency. He is a real statesman and a good representative of the fine great and hopeful and healing and honest philosophy. The American people have subconsciously thought of him as presidential material for a number of years. He is the type of man to succeed."

Calvin Coolidge got this for his support of Hoover: "This is his business generation, and he is a business man"; is unquestionable; the reason that assures him formidable support from powerful and well defined quarters—the reason why New York and many other eastern states will line up for him. Mr. Coolidge has said that "the business of the United States is business" and it is in this belief that the great industrial and banking interests may logically be expected to line up for Hoover as the logical successor of Coolidge.

As the antiphonal response to the Hoover chorus comes this expression from Henry A. Wallace, of Iowa, editor of Wallace's Farmer:

"The farmers of the West are not for Mr. Hoover at all. We shall never vote for him. He is a political ignoramus and an amateur that is not fit for industrialization of the nation. He is primarily interested in a rapid extension of foreign trade and building up a type of civilization in this country in which agriculture will play a smaller part."

Both agricultural leaders took on the attitude which Secretary Hoover represents with regard to what the standard point of agriculture, but because of fact that an extreme industrial civilization has started and can not long endure."

With the turning of the wheel familiar faces vanish and new ones appear—so Coolidge, so Hoover—so—but all the old issues, the old differences, the old conflicts of interest remain unchanged. That which both these eminent leaders represent is precisely the same, whether the protagonist be named Coolidge or Hoover.

In every civilization there has come the irrepressible conflict between rural and urban life, between the metropolis and the provinces, between, as Mr. Bryan used to say, the man and the dollar. And in every civilization the direct proportion as the metropolis and great and combined wealth have gained the overwhelming ascendancy, the seeds of weakness and dissolution have appeared and the fall of that civilization has been foreshadowed.

Herbert Hoover is a very able man. We think unquestionably he is the greatest government expert and perhaps the greatest business engineering expert who has appeared during this generation. In these and other respects he is immensely the superior to his nominal chief. He is, however, a poor political ignoramus. Mr. Coolidge is a politician of the first water. But he doesn't have to be a great politician. The interests that look with favor upon him are powerful enough to nominate him—in their own right. Whether they could bring about his election as surely is another question, of which doubtless they will give careful consideration. If they do, this risk is as great there is always Charles G. Dawes, banker and "iron" friend, to fall back on.

Cow camps are as scarce as they are plentiful but the camper is yet to be found who is out in the "wild west" with more food than he needs for his own consumption.

If you crave a meal you breakfast is well satisfied. Some real wild country may be seen by taking a trail to Shoshone, which breaks off the main road in the old Stratton homestead. This road is used so little that it is nearly grown over with grass and brush.
