## Terrific Blast Destroys Three Chicago Buildings

### FIRE FOLLOWS EXPLOSION IN ITALIAN AREA

Police Suspect Dynamic; Firemen Sent Gas; No Deaths Are Reported.

**CHICAGO, Aug. 21.**—A terrific explosion in Chicago's west side today destroyed three stores, buildings, apartment windows for blocks around and threw the neighborhood into a panic.

**Are Tenth Loss**  
The three buildings, were a total loss, and subsequent fire which spread to surrounding buildings did considerable damage before the flames could be extinguished.

Police believe the explosion was caused by either dynamite or gas, the fire department favoring the latter.

Although three men were reported asleep in one of the stores, a complete survey of the ruins by firemen failed to disclose any bodies.

Damage Is Heavy  
Two of the stores were occupied by retail mechanical businesses, and advanced to reason for the explosion.

Police are investigating a theory that the store was used by bootleggers to manufacture and distribute liquor.

Damage was in excess of \$250,000, police said.

### WATER PARLEY IN DEADLOCK

Only California and Arizona remain dissatisfied. Since the conference opened Monday representatives of the two states have taken up most of the time in discussing the dispute.

It was decided further that representatives would make no effort to adjust the present dispute.
