

TWIN FALLS MAN IS BELIEVED SUICIDE

Len J. Johnson, a farmer, who lives on Blue Lakes boulevard, left a note in his car which he parked near the low line canal on the road to Rogerson this

afternoon, bidding his friends and relatives goodbye, saying that he was "going," according to word received at police headquarters at 2:30 this afternoon. Of-

ficers are now searching for the man, declaring that they believe he has drowned himself in the canal. Johnson had been working on his farm and

after he did not show up for several hours his son started to search for him. The boy found his father's car parked near the canal and also the note bidding everyone

goodbye. The young man rushed to police headquarters with the information, and Chief of Police R. E. Leighton and County Coroner P. J. Grossman hurried to

the scene. They are now searching the canal and the near-by land for the man. Mrs. Johnson was notified of the discovery by The Times.

At 3 p. m. today the officers reported they found a cap believed to be Johnson's on the bridge which crosses the canal about three miles south of here.
