











## Students Will Get Responsibility in School Activities

Superintendent Smith Plans Development of High School Students' Home Government Change to Be Exemplary is Proposed in Honor System for Inter-scholastics.

A step toward bringing the modern day student to the problems of his later business and general life was taken yesterday by the school authorities who are planning to give their students more self-government than they have ever had. Sup't W. H. Smith said that the change to be effected would take place in all matters of students governing themselves the year because "they would not be able to tell the responsibilities—but that will be gradually brought to them."

The strides made in education in past years will be followed up and the students will be given a chance to have their activities carried on by instructors last year will be placed in the hands of the student body the day it begins.

In the new system there will be no take care of inter-scholastic relations that is, details that do not necessarily have to be performed by the teacher to conduct competition among schools in various contests and to have them look after themselves to a larger degree in the same.

Asked if he were thinking of installing a home government system, Superintendent Smith promptly replied that he was not. In favor of such a system, however, he said, he thought it fall too often, even in schools, and in some schools where it is unsuccessful.

In the matter of making available for students activities planned to let the students take control, at least in value of the funds and thereby gain valuable business experience, between \$100 and \$200 will be given to each student association and it is felt that much business experience could be given to the students should they be allowed to do so.
