NO EXTRA SESSION

President Coolidge has announced that there will be no special session of congress to consider problems which various leaders have declared warrant such a meeting.

The principal item of business which was to have come before the lawmakers, had the special session been held, was that of devising ways and means of controlling the flood situation in the Mississippi valley to the end that such disasters as occurred this spring will be eliminated in the future.

As matters stand now, the fight over the flood bill and others, such as the Pennsylvania election control, and the anti-trust action on the farm measure, will be the principal items in the last three sessions of congress.

Opinions differ on the method of relieving the farm situation, but all who are familiar with the condition of the crop are of the opinion that something must be done. Senator Borah, of Idaho, said as much the first day after his arrival at Washington during his visit in this state.

While conditions in Idaho are not the average this year, due to the many crop failures in the east and mid-west, sentiment in this state seems to be almost solid for some action in connection with agriculture.

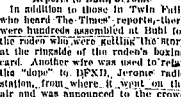

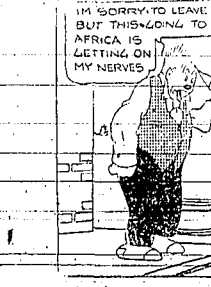
