life is equally impossible. The hottest day in our equatorial regions is cool in comparison with the multiplied seven and one-half months, the result must certainly be beyond endurance. 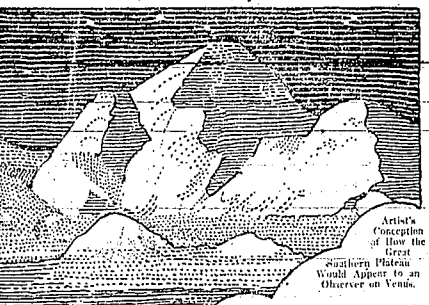

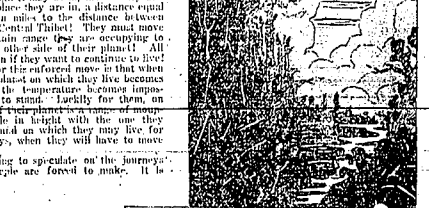

It is interesting to speculate on the journey, which these people are forced to make. It is

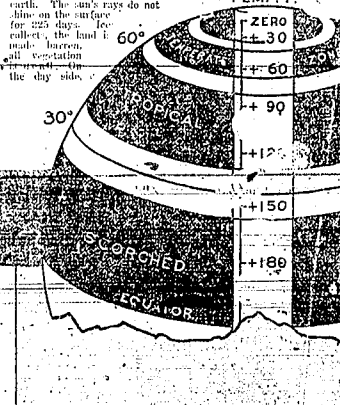

Lattimer, Wilson, astronomer, expert, who gives a description of the "new planet" as follows: "It was called by Sir Robert Ball, and he requires an amount of light equivalent to 250 earth-days to complete her orbit. This is 140 days shorter than the one known to us by the planet upon which we live. The size of the orbit followed by this planet had been definitely established for years when the late Professor Schiaparelli, who has occupied a conspicuous position as an astronomer, discovered by observing the so-called "canals" on Mars.

It is believed that the planet, thus Venus turned on its own axis but once in 225 earth-days instead of every 24 hours, as the earth does.

The theory advanced by Professor Schiaparelli as gradually came to be accepted by astronomers the world over, corrected by the known authorities as Hippen, Perrotin, Cerulli, and the late Professor Lowell have based their conclusions as to the nature of Venus upon the "canals" on the surface of Venus upon the "canals" on Mars.

To the mind untrained in the science of the stars, the fact that Venus turns on its own axis at once in an interval equal to 225 of our days is a very little important. It is remembered, however, that due solely to the earth's 24-hour rotation, we have our day and night, the real significance of 225 earth-day revolution of Venus is apparent. It means, in fact, that it may come, at a certain point of Venus, to always be in the "rays, while the other half is enshrouded in misery. It means that Venus has a day about thirty times longer on one year and a night of about the same length!
