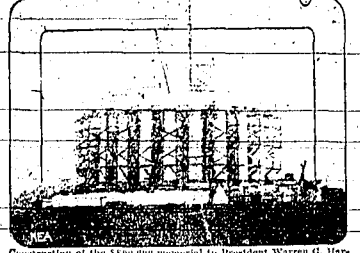

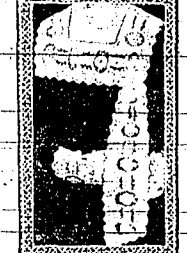

PITTSBURGH, Pa., Oct. 6.—The dawn of another baseball day for the Pirates opened with a razz by the New York Yankees as a result of their 2-4 victory in the opening game of the world series, as recounted by Pittsburgh opinion.

"Great mistake," these Pirates fans yelled out, "to have anything to say about a team which has just been supposed to have played with a first-class pitcher."

"Say it ain't true, Joe, say it ain't true," the American League champion have become to the favorite of the Pirates by slanting the first game. You can't make three Pittsburghers believe it.

Gene Hildebrand refused to say a word that first night to hear "What does it amount to?" demand of the manager of the "barometer" team. "I don't know," he said, "but the past four years the club which has won the opening game has lost the series."

Such happens to be the case. Last championship series from that of 1925 to the present has been essentially to the club which was beaten in the first game.

And on while Miller Huggins, the manager of the Yankees, has planned to take a chance and start one of his young pitchers, George Sisson, in the second game, the Pirates considered themselves with little concern and announced his chances for a start early to Pittsburgh fans, who are known as "skull practice."

First of all the Pirate manager announced he had called upon "The Judge" for pitching duty in an effort to open the series.

"I don't know how many times you go to his regulars who made such a disappointing performance in the first game."

"Skull practice" was no love feast for the National League champions today. Hildebrand, who pitched in the first or two games of the opening game, a game which the Pirate might have easily won, was asked to tell the club of leaders all about it.

The Pittsburgh manager himself had not escaped criticism for his judgment in permitting Roy Kramer, a tender pitcher in the opening game, to pitch. And many anticipated Hildebrand would have taken a chance on a pinch

In the first game of the series yesterday it wasn't Miljus' fault that the Yanks won 4 to 1, but that on the other hand, Lou got to bat.

Miljus, the lone player of Serbian descent in the major leagues, came to the mound in the sixth inning, replacing Harry Keener. Lazzeri was second with none out. Duncan sacrificed, Gulliss walked and then floor hit into a double play.
