



The Home-Maker Plans Community Dinners


Organization Is the Secret of Success with These Affairs, Says the Institute

Menus for Community Dinners

- Baked Ham, Candied Sweet Potatoes, Buttered Carrots and Peas, Cole Slaw, Coffee, Hot Rolls, Some Cake with Whipped Cream, Roast Beef, Franciscan Potatoes, Escalloped Oysters, Tomato Apple Salad, Buttered Rye and White Bread, Apple Pie, Coffee.

An attractively served platter of piping hot dinner set before each of fifty or one hundred or two hundred guests may not dismay the expert planner or team manager, but it presents a number of appalling problems to the modest home-keeper accustomed to thinking in terms of four to six servings. Yet it is the home-maker—it may be any one of us, no hotel expert, who usually maps out our popular community dinners.

As compared of just enough help to accomplish their allotment. Four committees will generally be sufficient. One for menus and supplies, one for coffee, one for kitchen, and the fourth for cleaning up.

The coffee is served in itself and requires one woman at the urn, or coffee pots, and, in addition, at least one coffee server to every fifty people. The coffee-maker also washes the urn and coffee pots afterward.

Paralleled operations are carried on by the workers lined up at the opposite side of the table. By having the food so placed on the service table that it can be dished up from both sides of the table, the efficiency of the hot-plate service is actually doubled.

Workers number seven replenish the vegetable, meat, and potato plates on serving table from supply of main range or stove. She keeps the hot plates stacked up for another one, adding, when necessary, from plates in warming oven or range or at back of stove. She also hands plates of hot rolls from a tray placed behind her.

New Winter Preserves

Orange Marmalade, Pumpkin Chips, 12 pounds pumpkin, 1 pound green ginger, 2 lemons, Sugar. Pare the pumpkin and cut it into strips one-inch square and one-eighth of an inch thick. Prepare the sugar by pouring and straining it through a cloth. Let stand twenty-four hours. Then simmer gently about one-half hour or until the liquid is transparent. Pack in sterilized jars and seal at once.

When the hot plates are served, the exacting part of the dinner is done, since the dessert has already been placed on plates and need only be lined away about an hour or two. It isn't practical to plan for so large a group a dessert that requires last-minute manipulation, so avoid a hot pudding. Similarly, to accelerate service we usually forego gravies and sauces.






