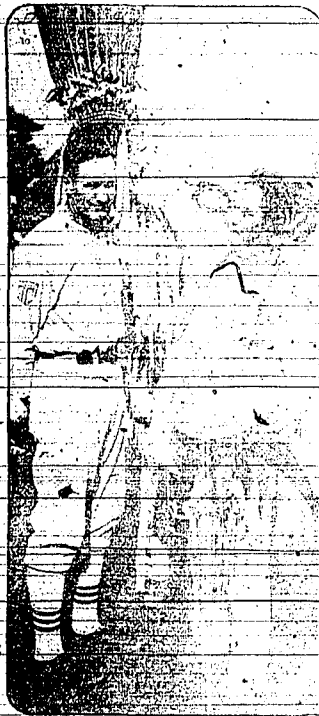
Goebel Plans Plane Trip to Australia

WASHINGTON, Oct. 11.—A flight from California to Australia next spring, with Art Goebel as pilot, is projected by the California Chamber of Commerce.

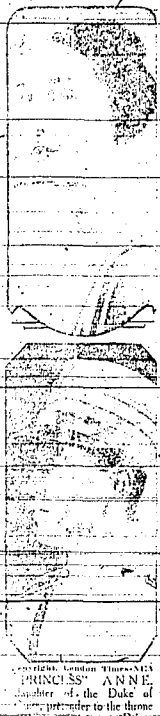

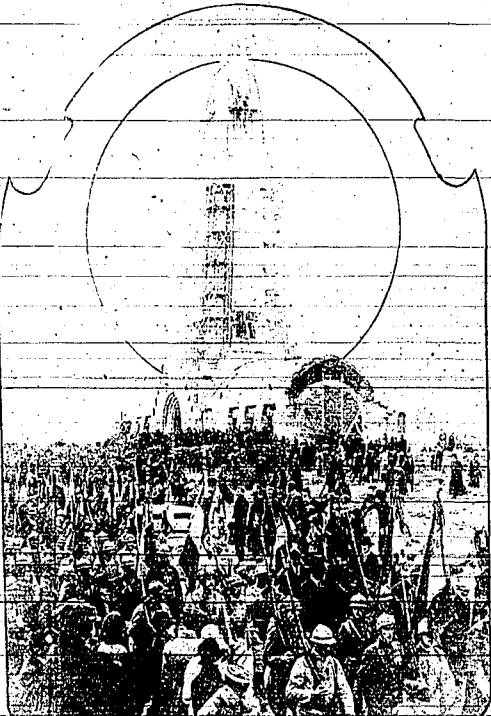

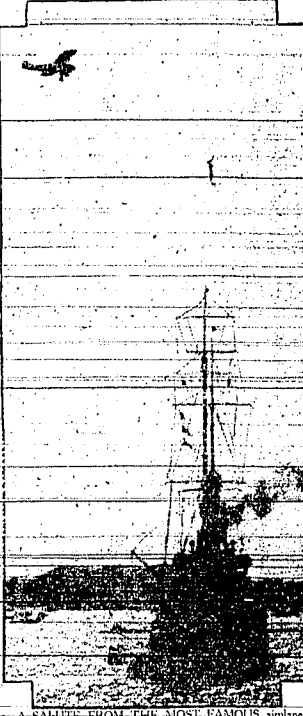

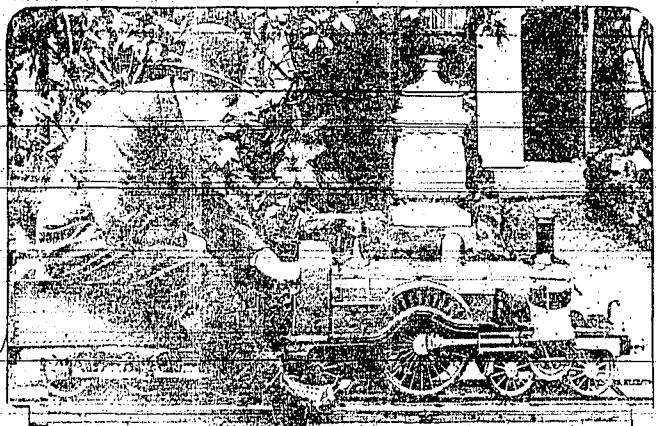
PRINCESS ANNE, Duchess of Gloucester, is to marry Prince Simon, nephew of the King of Italy. The wedding will be in Naples's early in November.

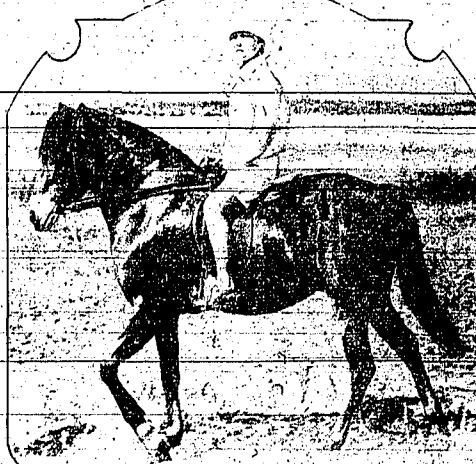

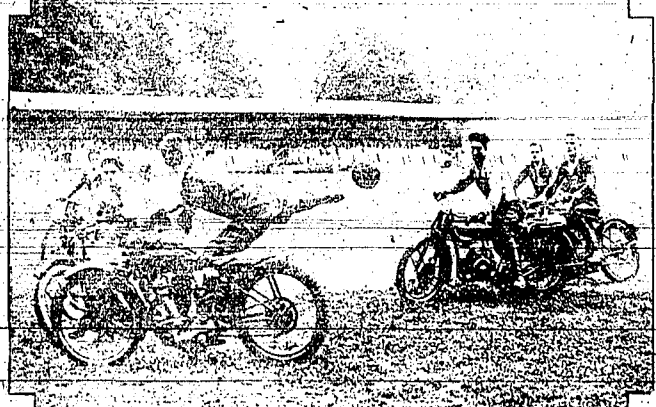

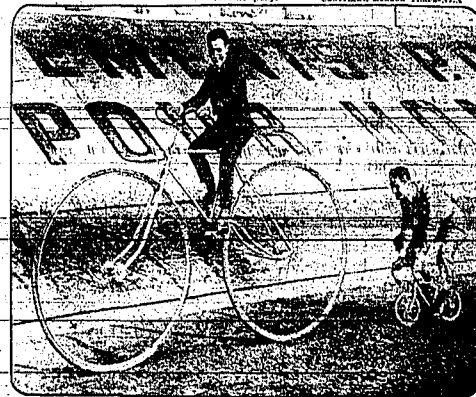
