



The small hat with the very close-fitting form is very well balanced, and looks good on all women, it is particularly suited to this young lady.



# What's in a Can of Vegetables?

Read the Labels Which Must Designate the Grade and Quality of the Goods



The Food Passes Through the Washing, Grading, Pre-Cooking Stages to the Machine, Which Adds the Tin Can and Adds Salt Value.

**W**E little think of the tin can as an object of unusual value or power; it is too commonplace in our daily lives. Yet nothing short of a miracle enables us to bring into our homes so many foods in cans which preserve their goodness and healthfulness for an indefinite period of time. With such a large proportion of housekeepers using these canned foods daily or frequently, it is important that every woman knows something of their preparation and distribution.

The canning industry of today is developed along scientific lines; its procedure is thorough, and its results extraordinary. First comes the canning of the raw material. Then comes the canning of certain varieties of vegetables best adapted for preservation. He has taken the string out of string beans, the seeds out of lima beans, the strings off of carrots, the water driven out of the cold air-salinated vegetables as are packed into the can holder. Then there, as well as all other vegetables, are packed hot in cans, just to the sounding number "one," with a seal.

In the factory, which is much like a large kitchen where machinery has taken the place of hand labor, the raw material is graded, thoroughly cleaned, and prepared for the can. The cans are filled with a definite weight of the vegetable, and hot, salted water is added to cover the contents.

After the canning, the cans are washed and sterilized, then packed into the cans.

Commercially canned foods are handled and canned within two hours from the time of packing. Thus the slogan, "If it's in a can, it's fresh."

In the factory, which is much like a large kitchen where machinery has taken the place of hand labor, the raw material is graded, thoroughly cleaned, and prepared for the can. The cans are filled with a definite weight of the vegetable, and hot, salted water is added to cover the contents.

After the canning, the cans are washed and sterilized, then packed into the cans.

In opening a can of vegetables, it is necessary to aerate them before using. Do not, of course, wash them. Cook for the

for each lot, each can, being its own cooking container.

To the average housewife, a can of corn is a can of corn, and a can of peas merely a can of peas. Purchases are frequently made at the option of the grocer, who often gets the grade and quality for his customers. So, when the housekeeper asks for a can of peas, and does not designate the grade and quality, she usually gets the grade and quality, the grocer has available. Under these conditions, it is natural to expect the often-repeated statement, "This is not good, not good in the best cans!" Of course, not. The first lot was a fancy pack, while the second was only of standard grade. Yet the housekeeper assumed that, since they were both labeled "Grade A," they were the same.

Every can of food bears a label on which an inscription like "Packed for the home market" or "Packed for the trade" may be found. So look at the label. First is shown the nature of the product, for the printed label requires truthful labeling.

The raw material is carefully graded, washed, and sterilized, then packed. It is unwise to show a green pea, or beans under the label, as this would give the impression that they were "picked from fresh beans."

The label must state that they are "Packed from Dried Lima Beans" or "Packed from Fresh Lima Beans." It is compulsory for all food-in-package form to show weight of contents. Again this is a good guide to quality.

Commercially canned vegetables are now taking steps to standardize the system of labeling, and it will not be many years before they are completely standardized.

Next the Cans Are Quickly Sealed, Lowered Into Huge Retorts, and Cooked Under Pressure After a Prompt Cooling in Water. They are Labelled.

Cans are marketed only in a size-size of container, while in truth they are at least five. They are called Nos. 1, 2, 2½, 3 and 10.

Labels indicate the size of cans, which answer your needs.

Quality and size determine the grade of canned vegetables. In

general, the larger the size of cans, the better quality, and the more expensive.

## WATERWAY OBSTRUCTION.

Opposition in Canada to the proposed deep waterway from the Great Lakes to the Pacific, the St. Lawrence is centered almost entirely in Montreal, as American opposition centers in New York. The Montreal argument is more interesting than convincing.

That day, now the leading port of Canada by virtue of its being the first of deep-draught navigation on the St. Lawrence, insists that if the river were deepened above it, ocean shipping would pass right through without stopping, and that would be ruin to Montreal.

Whether Montreal would really lose shipping business is a legitimate question for debate. There might be less re-loading of freight, just what share of the increased traffic in ship shape Montreal would get, under the new system, is a matter for experts to determine. Probably it would still get enough to sustain its prosperity. But the really interesting thing is a fact which Mount really ignores.

It was Dominion money that made Montreal the head of navigation. Canada spent many millions of dollars in dredging a 50-foot channel up to Montreal, so that deep sea vessels might come to her docks. That was what made Montreal a great seaport. Now, after having been enriched by the expenditure of national money, Montreal claims a vested interest and denies the right of the Dominion to enter the work further, making it a dead end, and offering strength to Upper Ontario. She claims no sharing transportation benefits with the upper river and Great Lakes ports and the population of the Middle West and western United States and Canada.

Thus ends this, when the West was involved. Always the West must find and fight for every mite spent and the right to develop its resources. As in the case of the opening of the big bridge-building projects, including Idaho's, it was a question of bartering with the East—a sort of dog-eat-dog affair. And now if the West is to benefit from the big reduction in transportation charges, which would be derived through the St. Lawrence outlet to the sea, thus eliminating hundreds of miles of high rail rates, it must again don its trading rament and prepare to support something which the East wants or the waterway proposition will never be successful.

## OIL OR BEAUTY.

The little town of Oxford, Kan., with a population around 500, recently faced a great decision. The residents had to choose between beauty and ugliness, between pleasant lawns with flower beds and an oil refinery. The town council adopted an ordinance which limited drilling to one well in each city block. Citizens did not quite agree on that. Many wells would pollute many houses. So they put it to a vote, and courageous Oxford voted almost two to one against repealing the ordinance.

Naturally this claim will draw to the attention of their trial now in progress in Washington, more interest than would ordinarily be the case. Not that the people believe it at all, but just to see what kind of a case the defendants can make on what appears on its face to be such a flimsy defense.

The government charges Fall and Sinclair deliberately conspired to take from the immediate possession of the United States Teapot Dome oil lands which had been withdrawn into a reserve for the use of the navy, that the lease was made in secret and that \$250,000 in illegal funds passed between Sinclair and Fall.

The supreme court of the United States has nullified the lease and returned the oil lands back to the government. And in doing so it took occasion to some Foreign Secretary of the Interior Fall if not uncertain terms.

Fall and Sinclair now claim that the lease was made in furtherance of the navy's defense plans they were mostly going to furnish some fuel oil for battle craft in exchange for the crude oil of Teapot Dome, that Rear Admiral Robison and the then Sec'y of the Navy Denby were responsible for the deal.

The trial has just started before a mixed jury. It met and two women. It will be followed with the keenest interest because of the prominence of the men involved and the character of the alleged conspiracy to make profit out of the natural resources of the country.
