SEVENTH GRADERS!

The average child attends school longer now than in the past. A decade ago we were a nation of sixth graders. Today our children attend school an average of 6.02 years making us a nation of seventh graders, and Idaho ranks among the leaders.

Most of the increase of years attended is due to the growth of the high schools. If the population of the nation had increased rapidly between 1880 and 1925 as high school enrollment has, we should have had a population of 1,660,507,505 in that year. More pupils were enrolled in high schools in each of the years listed in 1925 than in the whole nation in 1880. California, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Massachusetts, Michigan, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas and Wisconsin. Although the population increased only 79 per cent between 1880 and 1925, the high school attendance increased 2,365 per cent from 110,277 pupils to 3,650,903.

Some states have definitely reached high school in their average educational achievement. Children attend school 9.08 years; they have had the benefit of high school. Utah is next with 8.97 years, then New Jersey, with 8.83; New York sixth with 8.63. These states and a few others have graduated from grammar school.

The other states, in order are: Oregon, New Hampshire, Illinois, Wisconsin, District of Columbia, Idaho, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Washington, Vermont, Michigan, Kansas, Nebraska, North Dakota, Nevada, Missouri, Montana, Minnesota, California, Delaware, Indiana, Wyoming, Maryland, Colorado, Connecticut, New Mexico, South Dakota, Texas, Oklahoma, West Virginia, Tennessee, Virginia, Florida, North Carolina, Louisiana, Arizona, Georgia, Arkansas, Kentucky, South Carolina, Mississippi and Alabama.

A WORD ABOUT ROADS.

(From the Glasgow, Mont., Courier)

Within the last few weeks, the publisher of The Courier has traveled over many of the principal and eastern Washington highways. We failed to keep it our own trade but the mileage must have run up pretty close to 3,000.

There is a marked difference in the quality of Montana roads and those of the two states on our west, with Montana, in the red. A fellow traveler was disposed to the opinion that political ferment might have something to do with it, but no, Idaho and Washington took advantage of federal aid for road building several years before Montana did. Their road-building program dictates ours just about four years, consequently they are farther along on their program. And there is another reason. The area of Montana equals that of the two states on the west, combined.

This year Montana roads were washed and rutted by heavy rains for more than two months. And yet at the present time its roads show great improvement as compared with one year ago.

There is some talk of a bond issue to speed up the good roads program of this state and some good argument is being advanced in favor of the plan. But whether this is done or not but few years will elapse until this state will have a system of highways which will compare favorably with those of any of the states, east or west.

YALE'S GREATEST STAR BARRED ON EVE OF PRINCETON STRUGGLE

Caldwell: Found to have played two games as Freshman four years ago—disappears; Eli Rallics beat Princeton.

NEW HAVEN, Nov. 9.—Yale today faced the prospect of a trying football season without its greatest star, Princeton without its services as Bruce Caldwell, kick-field star.

Decluded, practically on the strength of it, was unable to mark the climax of his brilliant career. Caldwell had disappeared early today, while his coach, Eli Rallics, had called him to the conference table.

"I liked Princeton," he said.

"Sympathy for the play," Caldwell, who was found in New Haven, where he had been playing two games of football, while as freshman at Brown four years ago, was plunged with determination to defeat the Tigers, regardless of the cost.

Yale will feel Caldwell's absence in Saturday's game against the Tiger.

It was a year ago yesterday that Caldwell had played football as a Brown freshman four years ago, that he became his first association—

Bruce was Yale's brightest football star, a triple threat man, counted upon to carry the attack against Princeton. His record was unassisted by his brother, the boy was encouraged by a gigantic student rally last night to carry on and win.

The Yale News printed an opinion of the Law, "The Letter of the Law."

"College sport Yale recognizes as her first duty complete adherence in every and all respects to the mutual agreement," it said.

"When the test comes up it did yesterday with the disclosure of old seedy minutiae concerning the champion," it said.

"Out of our great right arm and apologize, to past opponents for any harm it may have done them."

"But in the broader perspective of the rule of law, the letter of the law," it said, "is the best guarantee of the safety of the individual."

"It is much more important that the letter of the law than the spirit that contaminates college athletics today. What difference does it make whether a man has played football three years or 20 years, as long as he does it in principle, we welcome the dis-

closure. It is only its wilful timing at the eleventh hour before a contest between two of the oldest and most respected colleges of the country that we deplore."
