## BACKER TELLS GILES TO FLY

Rosenwarne Tired of Publicity  
With No Result Other  
Than Expenses.

FREDERICK H. ROSENWARNE, the plowboy turned movie star and publicity man, who has been the subject of a great deal of British attention since he came to California on a picture flight to Australia by his father here, William H. Rosenwarne, a citizen of New Zealand.

"I don't care to discuss the story and get into trouble," he said. "I am not telephoned every day by reporters from all over the United States, who want to know what I am doing at the moment."

This was the first public intimation of friction between the father and his son, in California, in the course of the last month. The Zealander already had given some thought to the project.

Referring to a report that Captain Giles had had the most difficult instance of bad weather in his life, and did not understand this unless the pilot also had to fly in stormy headwinds,

"He's right," said Captain Giles.
