MAKING THE POTATO DO FULL DUTY

It is the representations made to Twin Falls district business men with regard to erection and operation of an alcohol distilling plant, a new way of going up for disposal of the lower grades of Idaho potatoes, the seeds and culls.

What is of still more importance in the eyes of potato growers and keen-minded men interested either directly or indirectly in the industry, is the prospect of Idaho shipping more than 100,000 potatoes to the markets of the United States.

Still another significant revolution in competition with this proposed local enterprise is that in Germany today there are something like fifty-three thousand alcohol distilleries in operation as compared with less than one hundred in the United States.

Naturally the prospect of local potato growers being able to realize around \$14 to \$15 per ton for their seeds and culls is an alluring one. If that is submitted by Mr. Penrose, is true and can be demonstrated, then the farmers are a happy lot.

There may be skeptics and doubters—it will be well for the proposed enterprise if there are. Nothing definite, one or will be done until every detail of the proposition is worked out to the complete satisfaction of a group of men who will be an advisory committee assigned to the Chamber of Commerce, so it may be taken for granted that prompt action will result.

Capital punishment should exist in all States or none. If a man commits a heinous crime in Michigan, the worst he can get is life imprisonment. The same crime in most States would demand the death penalty. A standardization of punishment is necessary if only in fairness to the criminal.

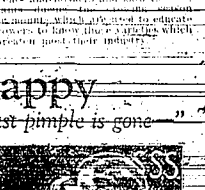

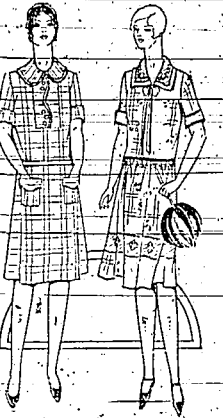
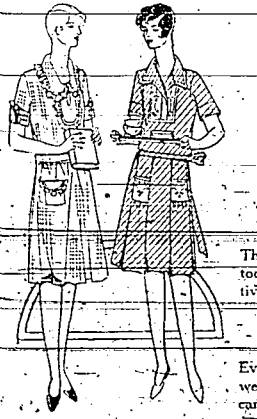
