CRIME NOT A DISEASE BUT A SYMPTOM

In all the discussion evoked by the report of the sub-committee of the National Crime Commission, no accounting seems to be taken of one pertinent fact.
The lenient judge, the ignorant and over-sympathetic jury, the inefficient police, the crooked prosecuting attorney all receive more or less credit and deserved praise. Crime is pronounced the most lucrative and surest selling in which one can be engaged; that will be news as good to the criminal as it is depressing to the general public.

Let us suppose that half of the population should go bad. Society obviously could not protect itself. The end would come in a year of extermination among the workings. What is it that keeps the larger part of mankind straight, working in legitimate employment, carrying on the work of the world? Nothing is so normal, just the innate desire to be self-respecting, to travel on the straight and narrow.

It is just the old problem of education, the ounce of prevention that is worth a pound of cure.

We are generally fighting the wrong kind of crime and in the wrong way. We have officers who exercise diligence in catching and bringing into court the criminals. That we do not spend much effort to prevent a continuance of an unsatisfactory situation.

Nothing could more effectively do this than the work of the Boy Scouts. The Idaho Industrial School, headed by Dr. Cook, states that there has never been a Scout in the school. Scouting is open to all boys who voluntarily come in. But when taken the time to go among the boys, whose mode of living has been all wrong during the twelve years preceding the day when that change is open to them.

Just as a plain utterer of economy, wouldn't it be worth while to adopt a comprehensive plan of survey that would sell the Scout men where most needs to be sold—the boys and girls who do not have the right kind of homes, the right physical habits, the right food and the right associations?

And since the root of delinquency is found fixed in economic adversity, in unemployment, poor physical condition and all of its attendant evils, are we not skinning the pollution from the surface of the stagnant pool when we arrest the criminals and make no effort to clean them out of the system of education and the financial independence that comes from employment?

Men and women will be criminals until they want to be something better, and they will want nothing better until they know of it.

SENTIMENTALITY NO SHIELD FOR SOCIETY

In the last analysis, the needs of the human mentality lie as many within the walls and word boxes as an outer world. We send millions of our best and finest young men to unimagined horrors and death on the battlefield, and we do it with lurch and acclaim.

We have no particular emotion over the fact that annually thousands of our boys die in the trenches, or that hundreds of our defenseless persons are murdered, and that is just a fact without apparent significance to the so-called human intellect.

But when one of the men or women has been arrested and tried by the State and ordered put to death for wantonly killing another human being, every effort is made to keep the murderer alive and at large.

In these many known cases why a young man self-confessed murderer, forger, thief, bandit should be still alive. If he is sane and knows right from wrong, then he should be punished or if he is not, and still equally dangerous, should be put out of the way.

There may sound to the sentimental soul a hard doctrine, but the time is here when society must see that such persons are a polluted stream which is contaminating the entire social body and that until it is cut off, there will be for us all no social sanitation and health.

Sanitization of defectives is being attempted in our own State of Idaho in such a careful and laudable manner that the most optimistic sees in it but another level fiasco. Yet that measure, coupled with prompt and painless removal of the criminal repeaters, are steps that are indicated if society is to live.
