FLOOD OF WATER TWO MILES WIDE, 50 FEET DEEP RUINS VALLEY IN CALIFORNIA; TRAGEDY OCCURS IN MIDDLE OF NIGHT; RESCUERS BUSY

LOS ANGELES, March 13.—Cutting a sixty mile path of death and destruction, flood waters of the collapsed St. Francis dam today raced through the beautiful Santa Clara river valley from the mountains to the sea.

No accurate estimate of the number of dead could be made at an early hour but it was feared final toll would be counted in hundreds. Property damage will total many millions. Seven towns and cities situated along the Santa Clara river were reported practically destroyed. The flood, unleashed when the Los Angeles aqueduct dam crumbled under the pressure of a cloudburst in the high Sierra, poured 38,000 acre feet of water into the river basin sweeping towns before it in its wild dash to the sea.

Buildings and homes were carried away in the terrific flood of water that tore a path through the cities of Fillmore, Newhall, Piru, Santa Paula, Saugus, Oxnard, Oberg and Camille. According to reports from Ventura on the southeast Santa Clara river became a raging torrent 50 feet deep and two miles wide. Wrecked homes, animals and debris were carried along with the flood.

According to word received from Fillmore, 100 members of the bureau of light and power camp at Piru were on the path of the water. It was feared many of the party may have perished. All bridges through the Santa Clara basin have been swept away, including the Southern Pacific railway bridge between Ventura and Oxnard and rail communication probably will be re-established for 24 hours at least. Red Cross chapters throughout the state are rushing relief squads to the inundated sections and D. C. McWaters, head of the local chapter, has ordered the equipment used in the Santa Barbara earthquake disaster made ready for immediate service.

WHAT HAPPENED WHEN SOMEBODY BLUNDERED

While every Idaho resident is glad to see the price of potatoes come back to the level hoped for last fall, and while there is universal rejoicing that, after all, all's right with the world, there is a question uppermost in the minds of the public which must find a truthful answer from someone.
 The chamber of commerce rendered an unquestioned service to the potato producers in righting a bad situation. But it is now apparent that there never was a basis for that bad situation. Last fall, the market was demoralized. There were continued reiterations that Idaho had produced a short crop which was more than offset by an over-production in much of our normal market area. Thousands of carloads of potatoes were sold for little more than the cost of growing, many for less.

Hot battles of words raged over labels vs. plain bags, over the effect of shipping number two grades, over the grading regulations, none of which have apparently had much to do with the situation.

We are now told that there was no over-production in the East. There was in fact a fair market for every bushel of good potatoes grown in this State. The present price warrants the statement.

Had the state chamber of commerce not inquired into the situation, an additional number of growers would perhaps have sold at a loss before the natural conditions of supply and demand brought the market back to normal.

And the question now of interest to Idaho producers is, "Who is responsible for the report that has lost to the State a sum of money too large to contemplate with equanimity?"

If the chamber of commerce will tell us that, there will be another very tangible reason for gratitude.

JAPAN GOING THROUGH A SAD EXPERIENCE

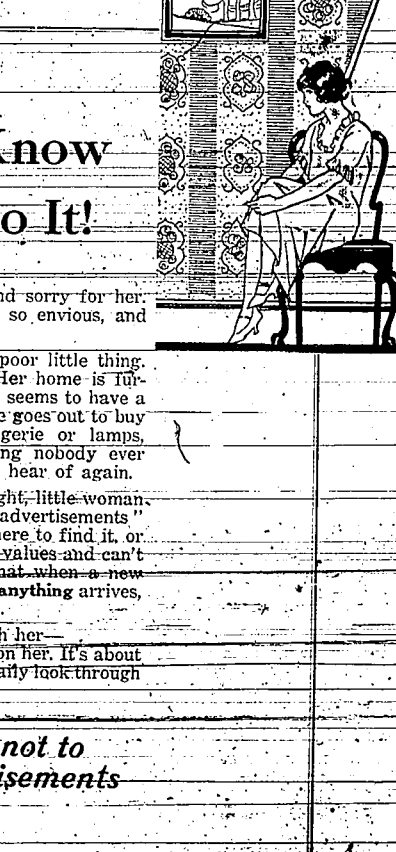

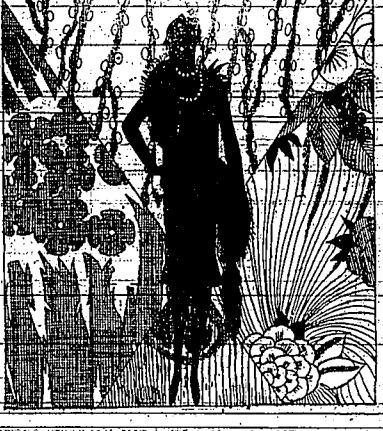
