## CALLES ASKS FACTIONS TO UNITE FOR SAKE OF MEXICO

### Nation Pays Final Respects To Memory of Dead Leader

### CALLES APT TO BE PRESIDENT 2 YEARS MORE

Would Solve Difficulty of Filling Executive Office; Police Refuse to Divulge Information Regarding Assassins' Motives.

MEXICO CITY, July 19.—President Calles is likely to remain in office for two years more in order to overcome the difficulties of filling the executive after the assassination of President-elect Obregon. It was indicated authoritatively today.

Though there could be no official indication regarding the presidential succession until the parliamentary committee had concluded its meeting, several Obregonists—leaders already—but quoted sources said that if necessary a constitutional amendment should be passed to enable him to remain.

Police are investigating nothing regarding the investigation of the incidents that lay behind Obregon's assassination. It is agreed generally that the assassin has been identified as Jose de Leon Toral, but even this has not been definitely established.

Photographs of Toral reveal a boyish face, with regular features, and a slight figure of medium height. Obregonists asserted yesterday that a constitutional amendment would be presented to congress under which Calles' term would be extended so that instead of leaving office December 1, at the end of his second, Calles would remain in office for six years, until December 1, 1930.

Obregon would have served for six years. A constitutional amendment providing for a six year instead of four year presidential term, Calles had announced he would not take advantage of the situation, but he left before the end of that time a regular election could be held and a successor named.

"As Obregon's body was en route for burial to the Sonora capital, the congressional committee invited me to consider the succession to the presidency. This committee handles legislative matters during congressional recesses. Congress does not meet until September 1.

Calles appears too grief-stricken to discuss the presidential situation to the moment.

### POLICE PATROL ALL STREETS IN BORDER CITIES

Precautionary Measures Are Taken By Authorities in Mexico.

MOGABE, Son., Mex., July 19.—Police patrolled the streets of all border cities and garrisons were held ready to meet the body of Gen. Alvaro Obregon, assassinated president-elect of Mexico.

On completion of a southbound train from here, was halted at Eureka, Sonora, and passengers in the coaches were replaced by troops.

Orders from Gen. Francisco Madero, commander-in-chief of the west coast, caused the move but the motive was not announced. General Madero's orders came from Mexico City.

It was presumed that the soldiers would meet the train bearing General Obregon's body and accompany it to Mexico City, where funeral services will be held.

Maj.-Gen. Alexander Gonzales, commanding the barracks at Tijuana, reported from San Diego, but he said he was under orders to hold his men alert.

Law and Order Will Prevail Throughout Nation President Calles Says in Statement; Assassin in Confession Gives Religious Fanaticism As Motive for Crime; Others Have been Arrested.

MEXICO CITY, July 19.—The capital impressively paid final honors to Alvaro Obregon, president-elect, who was assassinated Tuesday, and today leaders turned to the task of selecting someone to succeed to the presidency of the republic.

The permanent congressional commission, representing the adjourned congress, meets today and it is likely the matter of Obregon's successor will arise.

The warrior who came out of the north to rule the country for one four-year term and who was elected July 1 for another term, had not officially been proclaimed the president-elect.

That complicated matters. There was likelihood that President Plutarco Calles would rule the July election was no election.

At this moment seems the logical successor to Obregon's place as the next leader, but the president remains silent on the question.

Throughout the republic, innumerable actions had been reported resulting from news of Obregon's assassination by a young anarchist in a number of cities.

It was reported to be Jose de Leon Toral, 25, gave a confession that included religious fanaticism as basis of the crime.

Others have been arrested, particularly those including the proprietor of the restaurant in which Obregon was killed, and 12 employees.

The confessed assassin, however, denied that he was responsible for the crime.

Law and order will prevail throughout the republic, it was their unanimous opinion, and they called for revolutionary groups to unite for the general betterment of the nation.

The statement in part: "The inexcusable crime whereby General Obregon lost his life was so cowardly and abominably committed that it justified the most complete condemnation."

"I intend to chastise not only the material author of this terrible murder but also to discover and punish completely whomever they may be," said the new president-elect.

Passengers brought here described a man-faced woman as leader of the bandits. Several reports have reached here that she had been captured by a woman, Capt. Alberto Mariano, whose fingers had been amputated in the attack.

## CALLES ASKS FACTIONS TO UNITE FOR SAKE OF MEXICO

### Nation Pays Final Respects To Memory of Dead Leader

### CALLES APT TO BE PRESIDENT 2 YEARS MORE

Would Solve Difficulty of Filling Executive Office; Police Refuse to Divulge Information Regarding Assassin's Motives.

MEXICO CITY, July 19.—President Calles has agreed to remain in office for two years more in order to overcome the difficulty of filling the presidency after the assassination of President Plutarco Elias Calles, who was indicated authoritatively today.

Though there could be no official indication regarding the presidential election, the permanent congressional commission that conducted the investigation concluded he might several Obregonists leaders already have been quoted as saying that Calles should remain in office, and that such a course should be pursued.

Police are divulging nothing regarding their investigation of the killing of Calles, which they say was committed by a member of his staff.

Obregonists sources said today that a constitutional amendment would be proposed to combat the difficulty of finding a fresh hand to succeed him instead of leaving office December 1, at the end of the four year term for which he was elected. Calles would remain in office for two years until December 1, 1930.

Obregon would have served for six years. A constitutional amendment was passed several months ago providing a six year term for the permanent federal term. Calles had announced he would not take advantage of the extension but would leave office in Obregon's favor.

Several Obregonists have urged Calles to remain in office, if he would remain, for the two years mentioned, the election difficulty would be solved, for at the end of that time a regular election could be held and a new president named.

An Obregonist was en route to hurl himself to the Senate to demand a permanent place on the committee to consider the succession to the presidency. This committee handles legislative matters during congressional recess. Calles does not return to Mexico until September 1.

Calles appears too grief-stricken to discuss the presidential situation at the moment.

### POLICE PATROL ALL STREETS IN BORDER CITIES

Precautionary Measures Are Taken By Authorities in Mexico.

The bullet of the cowardly assassin have robbed that unfortunate country of the peace and safety for which she has been so long striving, and precipitated the government into the hazards of a revolution, while the people were preparing for the reception of the body of their beloved hero, Emilio Carranza, good will filer.

What lay behind the murder of General Alvaro Obregon, president-elect of the country, is not known. The murderer refuses to speak, and officials have not yet connected him with any of the known factions which divide that unhappy country.

Under the guise of friendship, the assassin approached his victim, and while engaging his attention with the pretense of showing him pictures, he fired several bullets into the body of the man whom his fellows had chosen as their leader for the next four years.

With Obregon's known opposition to the identification of the Church with the State, suspicion has not hesitated to point toward those who favor a return to the old system in Mexico, which President Calles has been instrumental in changing.

With his known friendliness toward the United States, the fanatical element who find in this country a continual menace and aggression, are under suspicion. Difficult as it may be to ascertain the motive which actuated the deplorable deed, it is far less than the difficulty of restoring to Mexico the measure of peace and stable government which they had had for the past two months.

A man of proven ability, for the second time the choice of the people as their leader, General Obregon had at heart the real industrial progress and education of his people, and in his death the country has experienced a loss which has evoked the warmest sympathy of the United States. That this should have happened at the time when hope for a better understanding for marked progress and for stable government had become almost a certainty in the minds of many Mexicans and many citizens of this country, is indeed a discouraging and deplorable thing.

Dr. Klein answers that question when he reports that since 1900, more than 760,000 men are driving automobiles, one hundred thousand more write life insurance, more than two hundred thousand teach, 125,000 more distribute motion picture films, 170,000 more operate beauty shops and barber shops, 325,000 more operate eating houses while the radio industry, aviation, tourist bureaus and advertising agencies take care of other thousands, and so it goes.

These United States offer a vast field for industry, the people who reside here are increasing the demand for so-called luxuries or at least are quietly but thoroughly raising the standards of living so that somebody has to be on the job to meet the new requirement.

And that is where the labor shift is cared for; that is the reason why this country is always forging ahead, because we of today are not satisfied with the things of yesterday.
