# ALL IN READINESS FOR PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD TOMORROW

### Campaigns Come to Close and Winners to Be Named Tomorrow Night

The stage is set for the primary election to be held in Twin Falls county tomorrow afternoon from 1 p. m. until 7 p. m. Candidates for office are wading up their campaigns to day and will call it a final matter until the winners are announced tomorrow night following the count of the ballots.

A total of 3500 ballots have been printed and distributed to the various precinct polls ready for use and are ready to do what they can to speed up the election and get the returns ready as soon as possible following the closing of the polls.

Even at the dawn of the day of the primaries, the "Democrats" will still have a few names on their ticket. Mr. Brewer filed for the nomination of State Representative, some time back, but offered to agree on names to be written in have proved unavailable. Some light was shed on this matter, when H. G. Munson stated that he would accept the nomination if the people felt him their choice. This will leave one vacancy on the legislative ticket.

J. M. Shank of Idaho is listed as the man whose name is to be written on the ballot as probate judge, and E. J. Finch has not yet decided to accept the nomination for assessor. If he receives H. W. P. Shinn has indicated his willingness to accept the nomination for treasurer if the voters see fit to write his name on the ballot.

The "Republican" party lists but one candidate in the field, that of State Senator. They will endeavor to put their name at the top of the list by writing it in names at the primaries.

The "Republicans" have candidates in the nomination in all of the legislative and county offices. Competition is keen for many of the berths.

Voters are requested to turn out strong for the election. At present it is estimated that only about 50 per cent of the population of the county will appear the right to vote. The percentage was up at near the 50 per cent mark following the Civil war.

PLANE SHOT INTO SEA NEAR STEAMSHIP SAMOA

Amazing Story Told by Majors Louis Idzikowski and Casimir Kubala of Trouble With Fuel Line Which Compelled Them to Give Up Hope of Reaching Continent of North America; Later Engines Failed, Causing Huge Seaplane to Come Down Suddenly on Surface of the Ocean; Taken to Oporto.

OPORTO, Portugal, Aug. 6—Rescued after crashing at sea when their trans-Atlantic airplane had faltered like a tired bird, Majors Louis Idzikowski and Casimir Kubala today prepared to return to Paris from where they started on their adventurous flight Friday.

For 38 hours the two Polish war fliers had tried to reach land in their white Amiot biplane, half the time driving on towards America and the other half trying to reach Spain with their disabled machine.

North of the Azores the fuel line of the Marhal Plaudski started functioning poorly. The fliers turned back but 70 miles off Cape Finisterre the gallant craft, shot into the water, fortunately near the Hamburg-American liner Samoa.

The two fliers leaped into the water, swam about 1000 yards, put out to rescue them and boarded the ship. Neither was injured, but aboard the liner both fliers were taken to hospital and injured.

The plane was badly damaged. Later the fliers came here, Kubala insisting that they had not taken to sea. Kubala told the United Press of the crash and their previous day in the German waters.

It was at dawn Friday that the Marshal Plaudski started down the long runway at Lelouleur Field, Paris, and headed out across the Atlantic. The fliers had been given the warning against such an attempt in non-stop favorable flying weather.

"What of it?" Major Idzikowski said with a shrug just before the waning interest.

The plane was next sighted passing off the French coast. Then the British vessel Arctec assisted the plane north of the Azores. Three hours later another British vessel sighted the craft and reported it was heading back towards Europe.

Then came more hours of silence which were broken when the plane which had shot up into the sea was seen flying in the distance towards Spain over the Atlantic.

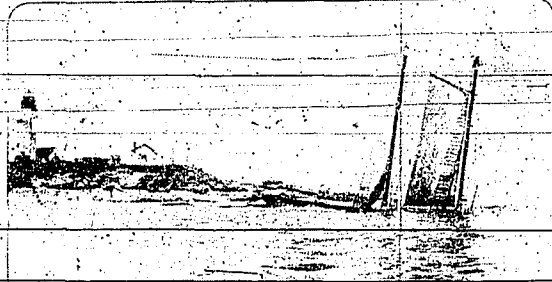

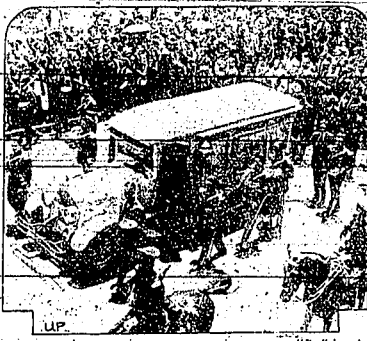
Hoover has indicated to his friends here that he believes in the future the United States will demand speedy transportation.

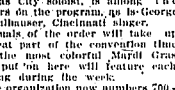

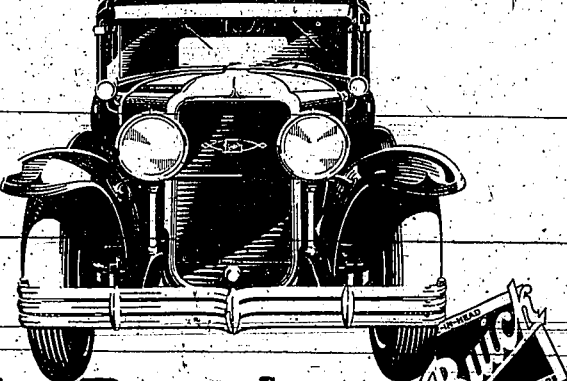
