Birth Control Not Popular in Mexico



The woman's husband is Marcelino Soroco, a lawyer.







Shoots Sweetheart And Kills Himself

PORTLAND, Oct. 2 (UPI)—Loring Hartman, 22, was returning to his hotel here today as a result of bullet wounds he had suffered, by Glenn Harrison, 21, his garage employee, early Sunday morning. According to the Sanitarium girl, Harrison had shot the sweetheart girl, Loring, in the head.

Harrison, a carpenter, was walking home from the apartment when Miss Hartman was being told her goodbye, informing the manager of the dwelling that he was leaving. Harrison called out to her more than 100 yards for her to return home, and when she did, he fired a bullet through her head, and then turned the gun on himself.

Police took Loring to the Hospital, where he was given first aid. Miss Hartman, who was being treated for a bullet wound in her shoulder, was taken to the Hotel Portland, 112 Park Boulevard, and called a doctor, Dr. George Hartman. Hartman had objected many times to the girl keeping company with either of his sons and had threatened to sue her if she did not stop.
