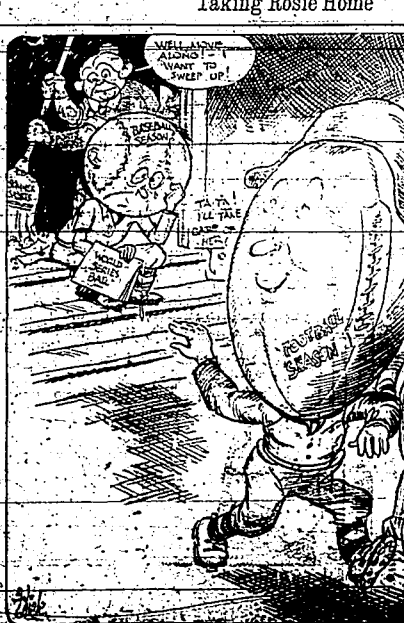

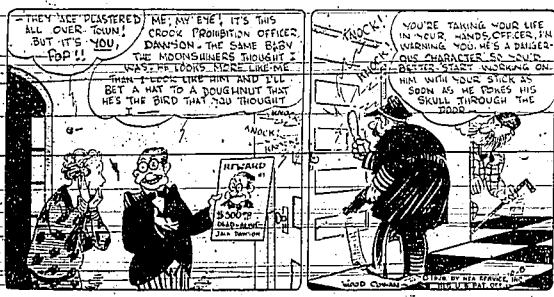
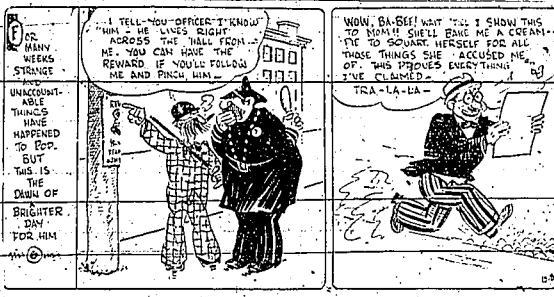

In his fervent desire to keep his shoulder blades well back, as directed, he is actually leaning over backward.

The recruit here has lost his true sense of the perpendicular, not through excess of aggressiveness, but through too great fear of being aggressive.
