PRISONERS LOCKED UP FOR BIG EVENT

SAN QUENTIN STATE PRISON, Calif., Oct. 19 (UP)—The stillness of death settled down within the walls of the cell today as the hour for hanging William Edward Hickman approached. All were silent at the time of the execution.

The hundreds of convicts went to breakfast in the main dining room as usual. They returned to their quarters and were locked up in their cells today as the hour for hanging William Edward Hickman approached.

The only sound heard inside the walls was the occasional clanging of a group of the cell cleaners as they worked the sidewalks.

Killer in Calm

Hickman was calm when Warden James Holohan called him to the morning.

The two guards of the death watch, Charles Allen and Fred Holohan, said Hickman's second flight in the cell of the condemned was not marked by the usual signs of the first night.

Most of the early part of the night he spent in short periods of walking around the cage during which he talked with guards.

He was calm when Warden James Holohan called him to the morning.

"Before I started committing holups back in Kansas City, I was a very nervous man," Hickman said.

"During those times I was extremely nervous," he said.

"I had no reason for a crime," he said.

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NATION'S MOST NOTORIOUS CRIMINAL CLOSES CAREER AT END OF HANGMAN'S NOOSE

Youth Who Saved Himself the 'Fox' Holds Composure but Betrays Inward Fear in Ghastly Color; Letter From Mother Comes Just as March to Gallows Starts; Reads It and Bursts Into Tears.

DEATH-HOUSE SAN QUENTIN STATE PRISON, CALIF., Oct. 19 (UP)—William Edward Hickman was hanged today at San Quentin state prison.

California's most notorious murderer in a generation stood for a moment on the gallows trap, a white-faced boy of twenty.

The trap that dropped the slayer of Marion Parker to the end of the hangman's rope was sprung at 10:10 A. M.

Hickman had been divested of his prison uniform and was clad in a civilian suit of black broadcloth.

The white glacial windows of the death chamber were here turned to black as the gallows trap fell.

Hickman's body was suspended from the gallows by a white cloth.
