### Ringneck Pheasants Disappearing With Excessive Shooting

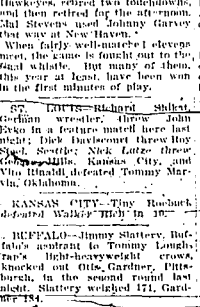
