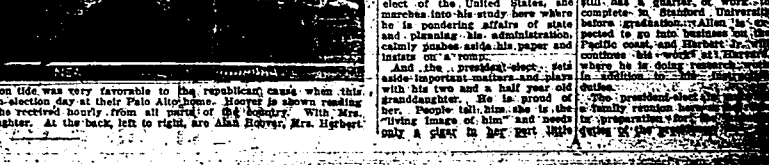

Perishable Fruit Trains Set Record on Union Pacific

Ten thousand representative fruit trains—carrying perishables from California, Utah, Idaho, Oregon and Washington arrived in the Omaha-Council Bluffs terminal on Monday morning, according to an announcement made today by the Union Pacific system.

This remarkable record has just been completed on the Union Pacific between Omaha, Utah, and these other states, and of particular importance to shippers. Since December 1925 not one of these trains has been delayed, and is believed to be a world record for freight trains.

The trains have averaged about 72 cars or approximately three-quarters of a mile in length but about six and one-half million pounds in weight, exclusive of locomotives. W. M. Jefferson, vice president in charge of operations, said:

The schedule for fruit trains from Omaha, Utah, is 63 hours and 63 minutes, while the rail from Omaha and the Pacific Northwest enters the Omaha-Council Bluffs line, it is 55 hours, 30 minutes. Within three or four days, the coal loaders must be set into them and the trees started and kept going by and weather. Also, at anytime while en route a shipper can divert a car to a different destination to take advantage of favorable markets and the large amount of switching resulting also comes within the schedule.
