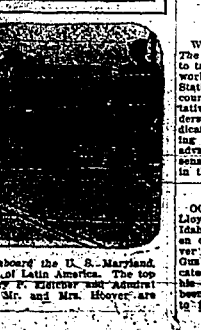

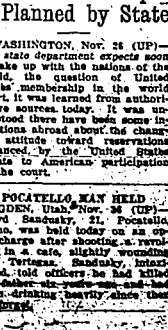

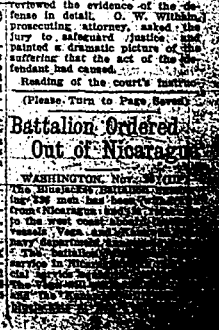

SOME time ago I had a letter from a Philadelphia man which was filled with good suggestions. He says he always reads my health articles in his home paper. The particular one which excited his interest related to headache. I am much interested in what this man says about his own habits. He is sixty-two years of age, he says, but feels as well as he did at thirty.

My correspondent says that his business keeps him closely confined to the office. He does not get as much exercise as he would like to take. He does not manage to get in a couple of games of golf every week.

He must be a remarkable man because, after going "round eighteen holes in golf, he says he has no headache. He wonders why his friends, who are "round" for a "good" game, get more than his "fly." It is really a remarkable record.

It would be interesting to know how much the eating habits of this man have to do with his excellent physical condition. He complains that most men who do not have as much exercise as he has are "in a bad way." This does not mean much at breakfast time, but always take lunch and then go to a big dinner.
