Although Twin Falls county started with an empty trengury, it will not have the expensive experience of other new counties in Idaho. In many of the older counties the county warrants go begging and are subjected to heavy discount. Not so in Twin Falls, When the first batch of county warrants was issued a few days ago the First National bank of Twin Falls announced its readiness to each all of them at par.— A Twin Falls county "warrants a pagod as a mational bank Although Twin Falls county started warrant is as good as a national bank note, a condition which does not pre-vail elsewhere. When a man per-forms work for the county he has the satisfaction of knowing that his money is promptly forthcoming. This means that the percentage usually shaved to the county and the people will profit materially thereby.

It is high time that Twin Falls had a competitive telephone system. The present service is so farcical that few take it soriously. A long distance call is a 25-cent joke and a local call is generally a mild and harmless lesson in clocution-and a test of patience. Patrons put in long distance calls in the same spirit shown by the man who applies a worthless brake to his, wagon going down hill, because it sounds good and makes him feel as though he were doing the proper thing even though it may be fulled. Telephone competition would add to the phone competition would add to the property value of the city and county and would amellorate conditions
which could not be worse.

With a few assessments yet to be made, the assessed valuation of the city of Twin Falls aggregates \$10,000 on a 50 per cent hasts. This is equivalent to an actual valuation of \$2,000,.000, a very tity showing for a city that lacks six months of being three years old. It is believed that the county assessment on the same basis of 50 per cent valuation will exceed \$5,000,000, which will give it a greater rovenue than that estimated at the time the county assessed valuation of the county did-not amount to \$100,000, the 'increase is little short of unryclous.

It is gratifying that the council ins decided to go ahead with the con-struction of the lateral sewer system Twin Falls. The system is urgently eded and if the lot owners in the listrict to be covered thow the proper spirit they can sayo themselves and the city a considerable sum. There is no apparent need of going to the ex-pense of bonding the district when a cash payment of \$30 per lot will cover the cost. The investment is instanti-cant compared with the returns which may reasonably be expected.
