

the county The city council has taken com mendable action regarding the domes-tic water supply for Twin Falls. It is an important question, and while the necessity for speedy action is appa-rent, the council is disposed to be cautious. The principal complaint at present is that the supply furnished by the Waterworks company is mud dy and the pressure is insufficient.

The low line canal, from which the supply is obtained, is carrying almost its full capacity, and as the waste water from that portion of the high line canal east of the city reservoi finds its way into the low line, the city supply is bound to be muddy dur-ing the irrigation season. This could be overcome by the construction of sedimentation and filter beds. A sedi-mentation bed, one acre in extent supplemented by two filter beds covering a similar area, would furnis sufficient pure water for a city of 30 000 inhabitants, and provide a re sorve supply for 10 days, in the even sorve supply for 10 anys, in the escale that the sedimentation basin were made deep enough. Many of the largest cities in the world are using this system with perfect satisfaction. In one of the leading western cities, where the system has been thoroughly tested, it has been found that the bacteria is reduced from 1000 to an average of 45 to the cubic centimeter of water. The objection to this s tem in Twin Falls is that it migh or it will rails is that it inight out climinate the alkaloids in the ovent that the water should be found to contain too high a percentage, and it is also open to the danger of possible breaks in the canal system. At kaloids are not considered harmful save when excessive, and it has been demonstrated that they cannot be wholly removed by either filtration or illing. Rock creek, as a possible arce of supply, has been investigat and presents many good features If it were used, the purchase of deed ed water rights, the construction of a and an expensive pipe and the safeguarding of the drainage would be necessary. This would en-tail considerable expense. The plan most favored is to drill deep wells in the city, connect them together and pump the water to a height sufficient to insure good fire pressure. By going down to the second or third flow it should be possible to obtain an abundant supply of pure water. The system would be compact and easy of supervision and while the cost of maintenance would be constant, the

expense would be more than offset by the superiority of the system and the

purity of the water. The Twin Falls Waterworks company has been an im Waterworks company has been an im-portant factor in the upbuilding of the city. Twin Fails, however, seems to be, outgrowing the company's facil ties. People are building homes and are demanding water service which the company appears to be unwilling or unable to furnish. Water users are objecting to the quality of the supply, which might be improved by fitration. The pressure is uncertain. It is urged that there is too much friction in the wooden mains and that the system of distribution is inadequate. If the company is unable to remedy the alleged defects in its system, it should join hands with the city in providing Twin Falls with a
