Working on Marble Creek Cases

Washington, D. C., Jan. 20.—At the regular meeting of the public lands committee, Senator Borah and Attorney General Peterson and State Land Commissioner Day in behalf of Marble Creek land cases. Speeches were made by Senators Borah and Brady, and early in the session Senator Borah and Brady addressed the secretary of the interior to make transfers necessary to enable the state to get lands of equal value to the lands in township 44 range 2 and east Boise, mettina, which are now under the jurisdiction of the department of agriculture known as the Marble Creek cases.

The Idaho delegation are solidly back in their seats practically silent. They have brought up no bills, nor do they know what the national government did not notify the register and receiver of the land office at Coeur d'Alene that the state had filed on the lands.

Several attempts have been made to get the department to take action, but so far nothing has been done to satisfy the entire situation, so far as the settlers in the Marble Creek district getting the land and the state will get the lands of equal value in exchange.

"This is a major conflict," the timber standee gets his land, and the state gets the best kind of equal value for our school fund, and everybody should be happy."
