## HUERTA INTENDS LEAVING MEXICO Dictator Is in Fear of Assassination

WANTS TO BE ASSURED SAFE CONDUCT AND PLACED ON WARSHIP.

Mexicans Beginning to Learn of the Insu-  
cience of False Reports of Suc-  
cess Against Americans.Vera Cruz—Perpetual rumors continue to circulate that General Huerta intends to retire from the independent leadership of Mexico on condition that he be assured a safe con-  
duct to a port and placed on board a foreign warship.It is deplorable in judgment that such a proposal a week ago, but was pre-  
vented from making by internal dissensions in his cabinet.

Clear Way for New Premier.

The disappearance from the Mexican cabinet of José López Portillo, a popular leader, coupled with reports that there is a growing undercurrent of feeling in Mexico City against Huerta, go to show that the general is forewarning of a change in the situation in the federal capital. Some of the closest observers of the government's ultimate aims assert that General Portillo's realignment may clear the way for the appointment of a new premier, and that another of a more conservative nature, who would accept the constitution, could succeed General Huerta as president. In these circles it is pointed out that Benito Juárez Carranza declined to treat with General Huerta in mid-May, in order to enter into negotiations with him concerning their future and facilitate mediation.

The effect of the continued inde-  
cisiveness in the north and the vic-  
tome of the pending attack on "Pan-  
ama" may according to well informed  
opinion bring about a rapid change in Mexico City.

Learning of Huerta's Decision.

While the federal capital was par-  
ticipated in the strike, which has re-  
sisted him, and that the majority there  
is beginning to learn that General  
Huerta had been developing the idea  
of foisting false reports of federal ne-  
cessities over the Constitutionalists.

A combination of steel and concrete made in such a manner that each material will be required to withstand the character of stress for which it is best adapted—that is, tension for steel, and compression for concrete—constitute a form of construction for short bridges and culverts, both economical and durable. The advantages of the two materials are combined and their disadvantages in a large degree eliminated.

This form of construction, on account of economy and simplicity, is especially well suited to highway culverts and short spans of bridges, where it is known that their super-structures be kept flat. In the case of arch culverts and bridges built


