Highway Commission Accepts Bids for 88 Miles of Road

34 MILES OF ROAD TO BE BUILT IN TWIN FALLS COUNTY.

Bids are still unsold. Bidders banded for the grading and bridges in Hancock, Gooding and Twin Falls.

Contracts were let in the past week by the state highway in Hancock, Gooding and Twin Falls counties.

On June 15 the bids for the proposed road building were received and two weeks were put in by the commission in reviewing them.
