GOLD STRIKE IN CUSTER

Seven feet runs \$3000—Eight feet does \$1000.

"Henry Walsh, the well-known mining man of Utah, who has been on the Lost Packer mine on Loon Creek above Custer, where he has been engaged in the recent strike made by Otto and his associates in the old Montana mine and to a Miner man, when asked about the strike, he said, "The boys simply don't know what they have, but it is one of the biggest gold strikes ever made in the country." The famous gold mine in Nevada, from which millions have been taken, "Continuing," Mr. Walsh said, "They have a breast of ore fifteen feet in width, and have not yet reached the hanging wall. For a distance of seven feet the vein will run out, and then strike again, and another will run out, and so on, for a distance of twenty-five feet."

The Montana mine is situated on Extortion Hill, which hill has produced millions and millions of dollars of the present mining of early days that brought the "rush" of gold miners to this country, but the mother lode was never discovered, and it is the general opinion that the deposit just found is the heart of the treasure of the nation.

It was stated that mining in this section has been done a good deal like it was in Nevada, before the recent excitement, and that with proper prospecting and thorough mining methods, it would probably be expected to yield a large amount.

"There are no miners who will start mining ore from their new strike in a day or two," said Mr. Walsh, "having made arrangements for operating the Sunbeam mill. This is a big strike, a wonderful strike and it should make a great deal to your country,"—Markay Miner.
