RUSSIANS DEFEAT AUSTRO-GERMANS

Germans Are Only 15 Miles From Ostend

REPORT AT VENICE IS THAT CHOLERA IS IN HUNGARY

Serious Land Slide in Colera Cut, Last Night. Fighting Going on in Black Sea.

Amsterdam dispatch confirms the report that the Germans have occupied Brugge, fifteen miles east of Ostend.

French newspapers declare that Germans were defeated at Arras with a loss of from fifteen to twenty thousand.

Reported that Netherlands has forbidden the exportation of petroleum. It is believed that this will have an important bearing on the war situation.

Reports at Venice are that cholera is making rapid strides through Hungary.

A late report today says that the Russians have defeated the Austro-German forces, capturing thousands of prisoners, details lacking.

A dispatch from Bucharest via Rome says that heavy communications have been held off Rastade in Roumania, on the Black sea. It is believed that the former German cruisers Goeben and Breslau which were flying the Turkish flag and which yesterday undertook to escort from Sullin, several transports laden with quantities have either attacked or been attacked by Russian fleet.

Amsterdam newspapers assert that Russian fleet in Black sea has seized two German steamers loaded with cereals.

Exact positions of allied armies being kept secret but believed forces of France and Belgium have joined since the fall of Antwerp.

Before the removal, the Belgian government is reported to have allowed all male Belgians between eighteen and forty five to join the army within twenty days or be regarded as traitors.

A state of panic exists among inhabitants of Ostend for Germans are known to have a large force within twenty miles of city. As fast as ships can be provided, refugees are fleeing to England, escape by land being cut off on all sides.

Extreme right wing of main German army has been forced to fall back before assaults of allies and reports indicate that invaders will encounter strong opposition in attempting forward movement.

Several hundred in Colera cut but night flooded all traffic through canal temporarily.

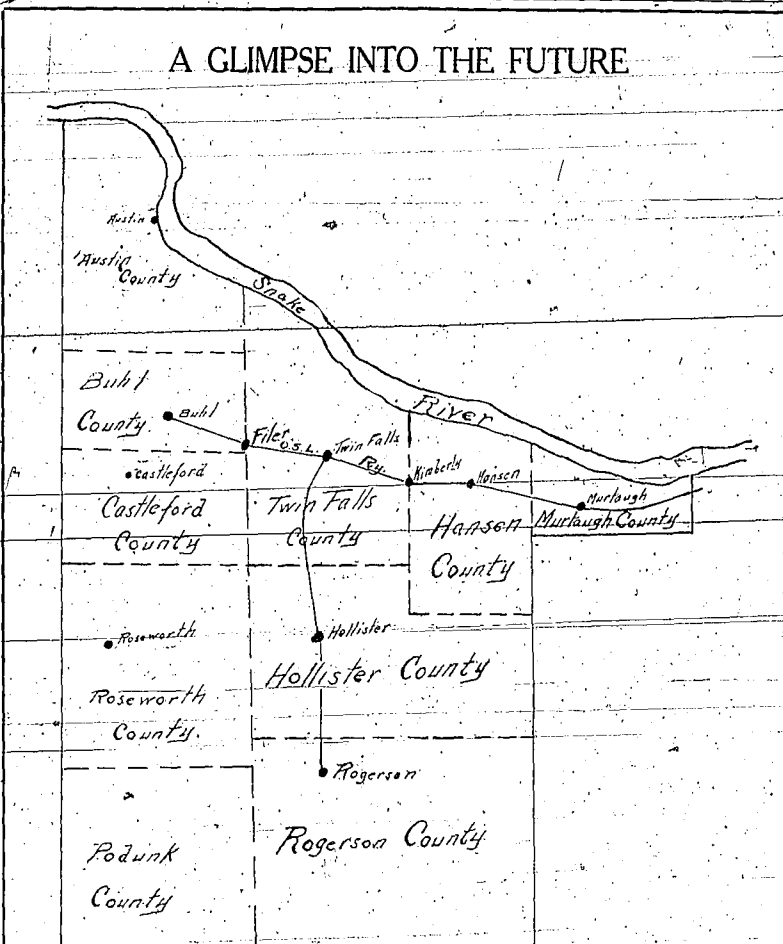

Short Line Freight Shipments Show Increase

SEPTEMBER, 1914, EXCEEDED IN INCOMING AND OUTGOING CARS

People Falling Off in Early Marketing of Potatoes, Outgoing Cars are Better.

While people are inclined to be pessimistic regarding conditions in this section, they can find nothing to ground for such views. Crops have been good, work has been plentiful and the merchants have certainly increased much heavier this year than last.

The lumber shipment tells a true story. The spot market has fallen off but the spot shipments for September were less than half of last year, yet in spite of this the total outgoing carloadings for the year by the track (which promises to surpass the corresponding month of last year by a much heavier percentage.

The percentage change in excess of September, 1913, is about forty cars and in the miscellaneous number, amounting to 4% are also a number of cars containing supplies which would be heavy market merchandise, so that the percentage of increase this year is a heavy one. The lumber shipments are the most important, indicating a good healthy, normal growth of the city and surrounding tract. But for the falling off in the potato shipments, 1914 would almost double September, 1913, for outgoing while the other end of the freight receipts can easily be seen to be away beyond the normal for the first fall, or crop shipping month.

SUGAR BEET HARVEST ON

Kimberly is Shipping Eight Cars per Day. Eight carloads of beets a day are leaving Kimberly for the factory at Burleigh, and this rate of shipment will be maintained until the year's total crop of 200,000 tons is taken care of. There are some 514 acres of beets planted in the district. The factory at Burleigh begins operation Monday. The other sugar factories in the district at Blackfoot, Idaho Falls, and Arco, began work for the year. These three, however, are owned by a different concern than the one at Burleigh—the Utah-Idaho Sugar Company.
