

BUTLER FIRED FROM JOB AS POLICE CHIEF

Mayor of Philadelphia Removes Marine General Who Went to Padlock Million Dollar Hotel on Dry Charges.

(By the Associated Press.) PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 23.—Mayor D. Butler today was discharged as director of public safety of Philadelphia and the mayor's office was left in charge.

Before he quit his office, General Butler released for public inspection a number of correspondence with Mayor W. Freeland Kendrick in which he accused the chief executive of lack of courage in enforcing the prohibition law.

General Butler asserted in a memorandum that he gave out that the mayor ordered him to "lay off the case." Mayor Kendrick made no comment on the correspondence, but earlier in the day he had written to Butler to support him in enforcing the law.

Assistant Director George W. Elliott succeeded General Butler as the head of the department. General Butler said he wanted the city council to pass legislation which would prevent any other person from holding office for more than one term.

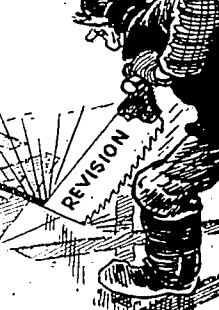
