TUCKER'S NATIONAL WHIRLIGIG

WASHINGTON—Although President Truman highlighted his social welfare promises and pledges in his first congressional message on the state of the union, economic conditions here are such that the fact is that he intends to proceed slowly and cautiously with his program of federal aid to health insurance, new housing and additional community facilities.

In fact, it is estimated that federal expenditures on the welfare front will not total more than \$100,000,000 for the first two years and probably less in view of congressional plans to trim his program for 1943 and 1944.

It is further provided in the Wheeler-Waage act, which passed the senate in the last session, that the house is to consider it first but bogged down for housing will require \$100,000,000.

BUNGLING "FOREIGN POLICY"

The Truman administration has frequently been criticized for snap judgments, hasty decisions and lack of coordination which have tended to weaken and confuse United States foreign policy. A recent incident suggests that this deficiency has not yet been remedied.

During his Christmas vacation, the President led a group of fellow Missourians: "The Russian people are a great people. If the Russian people had a voice in the government of Russia, I am sure we would have no trouble in getting them to keep those (Yalta and Potsdam) agreements."

Soon afterward, Col. Frank Howley, American military commander in Berlin, ordered all U. S. personnel, including civilians, to stop fraternizing with Russians. Colonel Howley was rightly angry because American and British fliers have been killed in the airfield that the Russian blockade has made necessary.

"None of my men are going to play footsie with the Russians under such conditions as their intolerable blockade," he said.

Mr. Truman obviously did not issue this order in Berlin. And Colonel Howley may not have read the President's remarks on the Russian people. If not, they should have been called to his attention.

Every government official with policymaking powers, from Mr. Truman on down, should know by this time that when the President of the United States says something that touches on foreign policy, his statement is going to be interpreted as a statement of United States policy.

But in this instance, Colonel Howley has contradicted his commander-in-chief's words by his own actions. In doing so he has emphasized the need for a general tightening of authority in matters of potential importance.

Such continuing inconsistencies make it all the more unlikely for our foreign policy to add up—a policy in the advancement of which we are spending billions of dollars.

CONGRATULATIONS, SHERIFF

It's encouraging news that Jesse E. Carlton, new Twin Falls county sheriff, has committed himself and his department to a policy of cooperating "with all law enforcement agencies in making law and order."

For the past several years, as the people of Twin Falls county are well aware, there has been anything but cooperation between the law enforcement departments, with the result that we have had no little amount of dissension and ill will. And we would have had trouble from these departments working at cross-purposes than has been experienced in years.

Not only has Sheriff Carlton indicated that he will have no more of this kind of squabbling during his term of office, but he also has plenty of evidence that the various departments welcome the opportunity to cooperate on such a basis.

Last Wednesday night, 30 law enforcement representatives from all the major cities in Twin Falls county, met at the sheriff's office to discuss law enforcement. A state patrolman, chiefs of police, sheriff's officials, city officers, a member of the FBI, Twin Falls sheriff detective and the state state director were among those present to lay their plans for an effective program of cooperation for law and order.

That's more like it. And congratulations to Sheriff Carlton.

OUR AIRPORT DOES ITS STUFF

We have a lot of knowing how many we've actually grown or our new airport at a United States air force four-engine transport plane made an emergency landing here last week with 19 aboard.

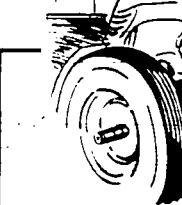
