Idaho's deer and elk are up against the worst weather in many years. After a series of mild seasons, the animals have come up with a haymaker.

The Idaho fish and game department said today the situation is severe, and called attention to widespread efforts to reduce the loss.

Deer, like people, enjoy certain foods more than others. High on the list of preferred diets is bitterbrush, rabbit brush, mountain ambrosia, chokecherry, and alfalfa.

Elk fare better in winter than deer. Primarily a grazer—that is, he eats grass when available—the elk can survive longer on hay.

These animals are not becoming starting to die. Nature provides for the survival of the fittest.
