Bodies of Crash Victims Returned By State Officers

CALDWELL, Feb. 12 (AP)—The bodies of two Oregon ranchers killed in a plane crash in a remote section of Owyhee county Feb. 3, were returned to Caldwell tonight, State Police Officer D. E. Kelly said.

The two men, Bill Jewell, 30, and Homer Harper, 50, operators of a Cessna 400, were flying near Home, Ore., died in the crash of their light plane on a flight to Caldwell from the ranch.



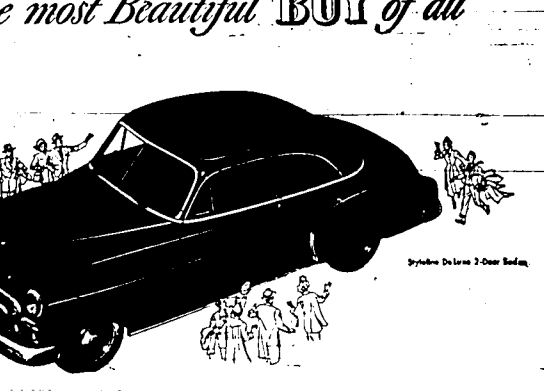

Funds Sought To Build New State Hospital

LEWISTON, Feb. 12.—Overcrowding, lack of therapy and a shortage of trained nurses are the most serious factors in the retarded recovery of patients in state mental hospitals, according to Claude A. Swank, who made a special investigation of conditions at the institution at the state hospital north, Croston.

Correction of deficiencies at the hospital hinges on action of the state legislature, he says. Bills are pending which would provide the necessary funds for better buildings and increased expenses of operating the hospital.

Swank reports the building housing most of the patients is in bad condition. The foundation is cracking, there are cracks in the brick walls; the foundation of one wing is sagging and the floors are scabbed to slivers with cracks from one-quarter to half an inch wide in them; in other words, it is a condemned building.

Of the staff of 52 people, there is only one doctor, who is also superintendent, one psychiatrist and three trained nurses. Many patients who would have recovered with proper treatment are confined.

Swank said he entered a petition that has passed a health inspection for many years. This is on record at the state health department in Boise. It is a room dark and dingy, with only one-third the necessary equipment for the needed care of patients and attendants. There is only one steam kettle and four oblong wooden tables. There are no cabinets of any kind in the main kitchen for the protection of food.

There is nothing in the present food preparation crews can do to help the cooking facilities as the present state department of health standards, the fault lying with lack of beds made up as floors, walls, cupboards, cooking utensils, doors and windows to protect them from mosquitoes and rats," she declared.
