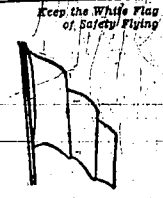

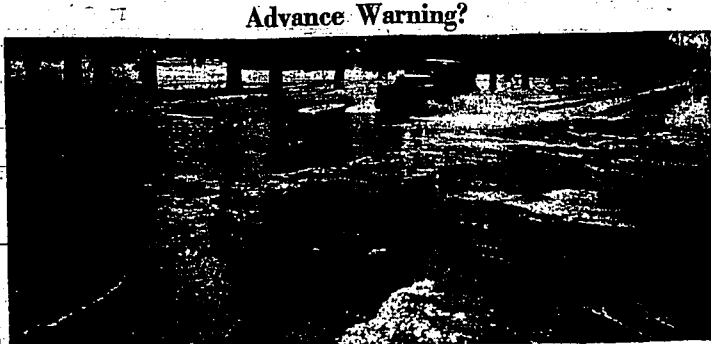

Baruch's Bid Again Getting U. S. Thought

A proposal for a year ago by Bernard Baruch to open up surplus non-perishable raw materials offered at a price 50 percent below cost again as one means of effecting President Truman's world development program.

The idea is that the mere existence of a ready market would create a tremendous stimulus for production in all countries, and that as production increased, demand conditions would offer less and less invitation to communist infiltration.

Before the end of the war Baruch and one of his associates, John M. Hancock, had predicted a 40 percent increase in the world business boom. Baruch told the Senate foreign relations committee last year that his boom period could be doubled by his "ready market" plan.

President Truman has long played with the idea that if greater economic comfort comes to Russia, then there will be a chance for voluntary return to democracy. Baruch has brought the idea before the Senate in the form of a bill which would set up a "ready market" program.

Need Barriers Removed? Baruch's proposal is removal of the barriers which still restrict the international movement of enterprise and capital. If France, for example, will not lift restrictions on the export of machinery, American goods will not be able to get into that market.

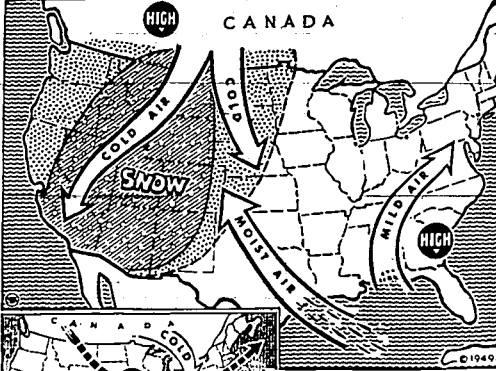

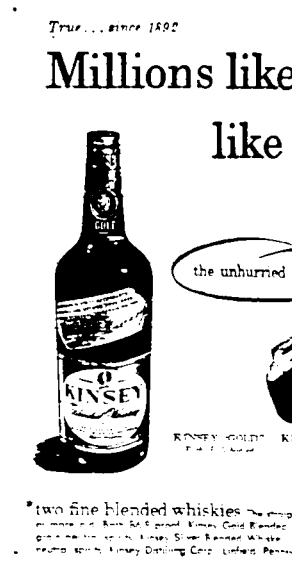

Cabinet Aide Renews Tax Rise Demand

WASHINGTON, Feb. 17 (AP)—Secretary of the Treasury Snyder renewed administration demands for a \$100,000,000 tax boost on domestic, industrial and business operations to such an increase while the 1938 economic picture is somewhat foggy.

Snyder indicated that "we are enjoying a greater prosperity in our history" and that the future outlook continues good. The recent price rise has been a "part of the essential process of reviving the economy on a sound business basis."

He told a meeting of the Federal Reserve board that the "nearly essential" tax hike is "highly essential" to help balance the budget and to pay something on the federal debt of \$23,500,000,000. Interest payments alone, he said, amount to \$5,500,000,000 a year, or about 15 percent of all budget expenses.

Noting that there is a "tendency recently to argue that reduction of the debt should be postponed until the business picture becomes clear," Snyder said he was provisionally for reducing the federal debt, this should be by:

1. The Snyder told the senate foreign relations committee he intends to "use every means no matter how unpopular" to make the debt payments.

The whole tax question, however, appears to be a "political question" to him even among the Democrats.

Some members have indicated that they will vote for a tax bill but not a similar slash in President Truman's peacetime record budget of \$41,838,000,000.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 17 (AP)—The farmer is getting a smaller share of the consumer's food dollar than he did under OPA, the agriculture department said today.

The department said that because of "marketing margins" account for 36 percent of the increase in the food price over those prevailing at the end of price controls.
