ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., June 10.—The nation's private power companies are planning a "lock-down" battle against what they term the growing social and economic menace of public power.

The private power men explained their opposition to the coming day of their 17th annual convention, sponsored by Edison Electric Institute, which made organization.
