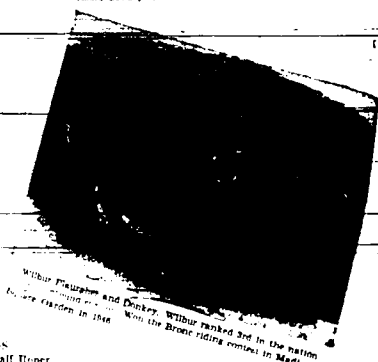

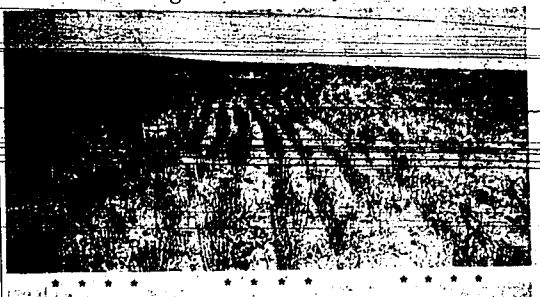

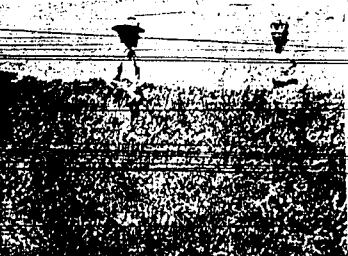

A report submitted by E. H. Prelock, former fire chief, shows a total loss of \$4,100 from fires during May.

Sixteen alarms were answered by cumulative total of 74 on-duty firemen and 16 off-duty firemen. A cumulative total of 105 firemen responded to alarms. Three engines covered 230 road miles. Buildings involved in fires were valued at \$20,800, while \$13,600 worth of contents and miscellaneous articles estimated at \$2,150 were involved. Insurance on buildings involved amounted to \$12,000; on contents, \$20,500, and miscellaneous articles, \$5,000. Estimated loss for buildings amounted to \$17,000. Damage to insured buildings was \$500. Insured contents damaged amounted to \$20,800. Loss to uninsured contents was \$150. Firelock's report also showed 94 fire inspections were made and three complaints investigated. Twenty-nine violations were shown through the fire station and 71 hours were spent by firemen attending fire-fighters' school.
