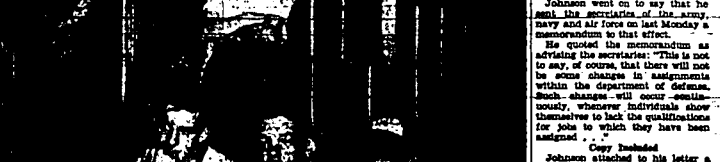

HOQUIAM, Wash., Oct. 28 (AP)—Almost a year to the day after he killed a relative in a similar hunting accident, a Hoquiam man was shot and killed in a hunting mishap near here yesterday. His own son fired the fatal shot accidentally.

The sheriff said McKinney was wearing a light-colored coat. The party earlier in the morning had sighted an albino bear in the area, and Kilgore said it was possible McKinney's son mistook his father for the albino.

McKinney was unarmed himself. He was unable to obtain a license
